



PRESIDENTIAL REMARKS: GARRIVAL GREETING TO HIS HOLINESS POPE JOHN PAUL II MIAMI, FLORIDA THURSDAY, SEPTEMBER 10, 1987

Your Holiness:

After an audience with you five years ago in the Vatican City, I met with a group of American priests and seminarians studying in Rome. When I happened to mention my hope that one day you would return to the United States -- and that perhaps this time your visit would extend to the South and West -- when I mentioned this, those priests and seminarians broke into applause. Today, your Holiness, you begin just such a return visit. And today, all America applauds.

Your Holiness, in a document of the Second Vatican Council that you yourself helped to draft, it is written: "In language intelligible to every generation, [the Church] should be able to answer the ever recurring questions that men ask about the meaning of this present life and of the life to come...."

"In language intelligible to every generation" -- certainly no one can speak with greater force to our own generation than you. In Poland, you experienced two scourges unique to the twentieth century, nazism and communism. As Pope, you suffered a terrorist attack that nearly claimed your life. Still you proclaim that the central message of our own time -- that the central message of all time -- is not hatred, but love.

During your papacy, you have taken this message to thirty-six countries. You have celebrated Mass in the ancient

capitals of Europe. You have spoken words of truth and comfort on the African savannah. You have visited new churches on the islands of the Pacific. You have addressed vast gatherings throughout South America and the Far East. Now you have come back to the United States, the Nation made up of people from all nations.

If I might just interject something, your Holiness. I know that in your travels you've made it a point to speak to people in their own language. Well, here in Miami, I have a little suspicion that you'll find some in your audience eager to hear you speak the beautiful language of Spanish.

But in this, the very month of your visit, we in the United States will be celebrating the two-hundredth anniversary of our Constitution. The document says a great deal about the fundamental values in which we Americans believe. In the words of the distinguished Catholic philosopher, Jacques Maritain:

"The Founding Fathers were neither metaphysicians nor theologians. But their philosophy of life, and their political philosophy, their notion of natural law and of human rights, were permeated with concepts worked out by Christian reason and backed up by an unshakeable religious feeling."

From the first, our Nation embraced the belief that the individual is sacred -- and that as God Himself respects human liberty, so must the State.

In freedom, we have built a great country -- a country of goodness and abundance. Indeed, your Holiness, it is precisely because we believe in freedom -- because we respect the liberty

of the individual in the economic as well as the political sphere -- that we have achieved such prosperity.

We are justly proud of the Marshall Plan whose fortieth anniversary was celebrated in Europe earlier this year. In Europe and elsewhere, we continue to place our might on the side of human dignity. In Latin America and Asia, we are supporting the expansion of human freedom, in particular, the powerful movement toward democracy.

Yet we Americans admit freely to our faults. As you exhort us, we will listen. For with all our hearts, we yearn to make this good land better still.

In Florida and South Carolina; in Louisiana and Texas; in Arizona, California, and Michigan; tens of thousands of America's fifty-three million Catholics will greet you. They do great works, America's Catholics, in the name of their Church.

Here in the United States, American Catholics put their faith into action in countless ways -- maintaining parochial schools that give underprivileged children in our inner cities the chance to receive a good education; supporting the AIDS hospices established by Mother Teresa's Sisters of Charity; perhaps simply helping to put on a fundraising dinner for the local parish. Abroad, American Catholics likewise seek to translate their faith into deeds, whether supporting missionaries in distant lands, or helping America's Knights of Columbus restore the facade of St. Peter's in Rome.

But it will not be Catholics alone who greet you.

Protestants of every denomination, Jews, Muslims, even many with

no defined faith at all -- Americans of every kind and degree of belief will wish you well, your Holiness, responding to your moral leadership. Even today's Florida sunshine is no warmer than the affection you will meet.

I began a moment ago by quoting from one document of the Second Vatican Council. Permit me to close by quoting from a second.

"By the hidden and kindly mystery of God's will a supernatural solidarity reigns among men. A consequence of this is that... one person's holiness helps others." Today, Americans feel this solidarity. And we thank you, your Holiness, for the courage and sanctity, the kindness and wisdom, with which you have done so much to help our troubled world.

On behalf of all Americans, your Holiness, welcome back to America.

> For the second time this year, I have met in private audience with His Holiness, Pope John Paul II. We discussed the practical aspects of ideals we share: Peace, justice, and the expansion of freedom. We agreed that, as the Pope first remarked when I visited him at the Vatican City in 1982, "Peace is not only the absence of war; it also involves reciprocal trust between nations..."

> With regard to the economic needs of the world's poor nations, I thanked the Pope for speaking so eloquently about what he terms "the moral causes of prosperity," among them hard work, honesty, thrift, initiative, and respect for the economic rights of the individual. Generous aid from the wealthier nations to the poorer is certainly of great importance, but in the long term it is even more important to share the conditions -- "the moral causes" -- that represent such a powerful force for economic growth and human betterment.

> Once again, your Holiness, welcome back to the United States. The American people welcome you with affection, and will listen joyfully to your message of human dignity and peace.





Dear Archbishop Laghi:

We have reviewed the requests from Reverend Monsignor Daniel F. Hoye and from Reverend Robert N. Lynch seeking the assistance of the United States Government in providing helicopter transportation for the Pope and his official party while the Pope is visiting the United States. The requests were based on observations made by Reverend Lynch during his advance trip as well as his consultations with the United States Secret Service and local law enforcement officials which led him to conclude that helicopters are necessary for security reasons. I have been advised that the Secret Service agrees with this conclusion.

We have determined that provision of United States Government helicopters to guarantee safe and expeditious transportation to the papal party is appropriate. Under 18 U.S.C. Sec. 3056, the Secret Service is authorized to protect visiting heads of foreign states. Accordingly, we will be pleased to provide helicopter service for the protection of the pope and his party.

You should contact James C. McKinney, Deputy Assistant to the President, Director, White House Military Office (456-2150) as soon as possible to work out the details.

Visit to the United States

We have reviewed the request from Reverend Monsignor Daniel F. Hoye forwarded through Archbishop Pio Laghi, and the request from Reverend Robert N. Lynch, for assistance in obtaining United States government helicopters for transportation of the Pope and his official party during their visit to the United States in the fall. These requests were based on security reasons.

We conclude, that as a matter of law, United States government helicopters may be made available to the Pope and his official party. Under 18 U.S.C. § 3056 (5), the Secret Service is authorized to protect visiting heads of foreign states. We understand that the Department of State has advised the Secret Service that the Pope is considered a head of state.


The attached draft reply reflects the view that the Pope may be provided this helicopter security service because he is a head of state. We recommend you obtain the concurrence of State, NSC, and Secret Service for your response.

SUBJECT: MEETING WITH POPE JOHN PAUL II IN MIAMI, FLORIDA ON THURSDAY, SEPTEMBER 10, 1987

On Thursday, September 10, 1987, you and Mrs. Reagan will travel to Miami, Florida to greet Pope John Paul II upon his arrival in the United States for a nine day pastoral visit. The arrival ceremony will take place at the Miami International Airport, with a crowd of approximately five thousand guests of the Archdiocese and VIP's in attendance. You and Mrs. Reagan will greet the Pope as he deplanes, then you and the Pope will proceed on-stage and make remarks.

Following the arrival ceremony, you and Mrs. Reagan will motorcade to the Doral Country Club, and hold for approximately 2 hours while the Pope proceeds on a separate schedule. Later at Vizcaya, a 16th century Italian Renaissance-styled villa, you and Mrs. Reagan will meet privately with Pope John Paul II. At the conclusion of the meetings, you and Pope John Paul II will participate in a walk/photo session in the formal gardens. You and the Pope will then make brief departure statements.

Following the Pope's departure from Vizcaya, you and Mrs. Reagan will return to the airport and depart Miami en route The White House, arriving at approximately 10:00 p.m.
