
Attached is the President's financial disclosure report for 1979.

- A -- any good faith estimate of the value of the property if the exact value is unknown or not easily obtainable.
- B -- value based upon a recent appraisal of the property interest.
- C -- the date of purchase and the purchase price of the reporting party's interest.
- D -- the assessed value of the property for tax purposes, adjusted to reflect current market value if the tax assessment is computed at less than 100% of current value.
- E -- the year-end book value of non-publicly traded stock, or the year-end exchange value of corporate stocks, or the face value of corporate bonds, or comparable securities.
- F -- the net worth of the reporting party's interest (as in a business partnership or other jointly held business interest).
- G -- the equity value of the reporting party's interest (as in a solely owned business or commercial enterprise).
- H -- actual value or any recognized indication of value (such as last sale on a stock exchange).
