RR signed legislation authorizing payment by a school district to the surviving spouse of any employee murdered while on the job during or after the 1973-74 school year.

BILL SIGNED SB 2267 - Mills #562 **9-27-7**4

RR signed legislation which directs the Department of Transportation to study the feasibility of upgrading rail passenger service to ease travel congestion between Los Angeles and San Diego.

BILLS SIGNED SB 1860-Behr and AB 4134-McCarthy

#561 9**-**27**-**74

SB 1860 - will train high school students to be parents.


AB 4134 - allocates funds for the expansion of migrant child care centers, including one center for infants.

BILL SIGNED AB 4040 - Lanterman **#560** 9-27-74

RR signed legislation authorizing a three-year pilot program to evaluate the state Department of Education's Master Plan for Special Education.

BILLS SIGNED AB 3650 and AB 3651-Bond **#555** 9-27-74

RR signed legislation which expresses the intent of equal opportunity for both males and females as participants in sports programs of the state's public high schools and colleges.
