Community colleges are concerned over the fiscal effects due to the lowering of the age of majority. (Finance is working with them on this.)

3) Student Financial Aid

The Chancellor's Office will be discussing providing statewide service for student financial aid in the community colleges.

The luncheon is to be informal, as always. You have no agenda but goodwill. I would get across my continued concern for career education. Brossman claims sixty percent of students are in such programs. You might request a report, out of interest, if he says so.
