California Rural Legal Assistance has been a detriment to our area since its inception.

Among the many adverse and cuestionable activities it has participoted in has been the Clinica Salubridad de Campesinos in Brawley. During a recent suit in Federal District Court brought by local people to enjoin the clinic, the CRLA donated the services of three attorneys to defend this group who had finagled a \$375,000 grant.

CRLA is known to be associated with a project to import aliens in spite of the fact that already 40% of this county's welfare budget is being spent on non-citizens. This is one of the major factors in the runaway cost of the State Welfare budget.
