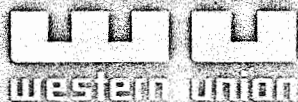




I noted in the Modesto Bee of October 29, 1970, that the California Bar Association requested that you sign the bill extending funds for the CRLA for another year.



I am very happy to read in Sunday's Modesto Bee that you have vetoed the funds for the coming year's operations of the California Rural Legal Assistance Inc.

My late husband and I have been very concerned over the tax payers money being spent on this organization, in fact we feel the whole Office of Economic Opportunity is a big farce. He has been in many arguments with the CRIA attorneys in Modesto. If the money would go to the really poor people would be one thing, but then they have their organization to get more money, which seems to go mostly to big salaries for the leaders it seems all wrong.

We have been behind you 100% mainly because we agree with most of your program, of course there are things we can't be for, but that is in all cases. 
