Ron, at yesterday's appearance of Oliver B. "Buck" Revell before the Senate Select Committee on Intelligence (SSCI) staffers, at which I was also in attendance, the staffers seemed to take a particular interest in an interview of Lt. Col. Oliver North on July 18, 1985, as transmitted to FBI Headquarters via Teletype by the FBI's Washington Field Office on that same date (copy attached).

The third page of that Teletype reflects the focal point of the SSCI staffers' interest wherein Ollie North states he discussed the subject's interest in donating to the Nicaraguan Freedom Fighters personally with President Ronald Reagan and National Security Advisor Robert MacFarlane as recently as June, 1985. Mr. Revell and I pointed out to the staffers that this was North's statement only. It is forwarded to you for information.
