

Attorney General Meese's Request for Tower Board Testimony

I understand that Attorney General Meese has requested a copy of the transcript of his testimony before the Tower Board. On March 23, 1987, and April 2, 1987, we provided Secretary Shultz and Secretary Weinberger with copies of their testimony before the Tower Board. I do not believe we should treat the Attorney General's request differently. His testimony was voluntarily given, was not under oath and was not part of the investigations of the Independent Counsel or the Congressional Committees. Therefore, I have no objection to providing the Attorney General with a copy of his testimony.

I have prepared the attached letter from you to Attorney General Meese to reflect this conclusion.
