SUBJECT: ADOLFO CALERO--Potential Testimony Subject Areas

Attached is a classified memorandum prepared under Bill Lytton's direction which summarizes the anticipated lines of inquiry which may be explored during Adolfo Calero's testimony at the Iran/Contra hearings. This analysis is based upon the documents available to The White House, prior testimony and publicly available information. 
