Attached is a summary of the testimony yesterday by Robert Dutton (a retired Colonel who worked with General Second) and Felix Rodriguez.

During the Dutton testimony, Committee counsel called an FBI agent forward to show Dutton a photo album covered with fingerprint dust (apparently the album was analyzed by the Independent Counsel for fingerprints). The album contained photographs of Contra resupply operation aircraft, facilities and personnel, which album Dutton prepared for Oliver North. Dutton stated that he understood that North wanted to show the album to the President. There is no indication that the President saw the album.

The hearings will resume today at 9:30 a.m. Mr. Rodriguez will continue his testimony during the morning session.
