State furnishes night notes, that are put into President's folder.

NSA's report, on overnight matters and long-range matters, press, one-page

Saturday, Pres. gets once-a-week note from Wemberger. Without exception, says Keel, Pres. reads PDB every day. Puts an RE on them

One step up from the NIT

Normally, paper flow from NSC goes thru Staff Secy.

In extraordinarily sensitive case, or those time-urgent, this goes directly to Pres. in 9:30 briefing

PDB is left w/ P., and he reads it after the meeting.

Walked back by Pres's personal asst.

Other items are discussed at meeting 9:30 - not PDB matters

Two private meetings by Secy of State Wed & Fri at 1:30
NSA goes, but it's Secy's mtg. Chief does not attend,
usually.

Secy of Def. has one private mtg. per week.

Usually, these meetings are used to bring up things
on which there is a difference of view.

Pomdexter would go in to see Pres. by calling
KO, but he would generally, but not always,
ask Chief of Staff to join him.

Casey has infrequently met privately w/ the Pres.; no
scheduled time.

NSC meetings generally include Regan, Meese, Baker,
Jim Miller, in addition to statutory members.

Bernie McMahon 12/5/86

It looks as tho what we have is some bones to pick w/ the agency such as notification to Congress.

In addition, we have a covert action run in a very unusual way and mistakes were made.

North probably exceeded his charter because he was an enthusiast. Probably violated Boland restriction

Pomdexter may have known in October that some violation of Boland may have occurred.

Has gone over this with Chairman. Some members want to pull additional strings. In the next Congress, many investigations will be carried on

No need for a select committee; can deal with the matter thru dealings w/ Comm.

Universal view is that we have to get this behind us and prevent damage to covert action process, Pres. and intelligence community.

Idea initially was to grant immunity, but we

Also said that it was not illegal. On one of the occasions he said that Iran was contributing to Oliver's Contra Fund.

Woodward says if this true then RR has not necessarily lied because Q has always been about the diversion or the illegal diversion of Iranian funds - which this was not - rather a contribution.

Woodward also recognizes the fact that this could be self serving testimony. John's attorney refused comment according to Woodward.
