With respect to Senator Durenberger's recommendations set forth at page 52 of the report, I would recommend that the following language be inserted in lieu of the last sentence in the last paragraph on the page:

Because hostage rescue and counterterrorist operations are sensitive and involve a variety of difference circumstances, no set of specific procedures would be appropriate in all such cases. Accordingly, it would be prudent to continue the informal discussions to clarify reporting and oversight requirements recognizing that (1) the President must have flexibility to deal with each situation as it arises and (2) the untimely disclosure of such operations could have potentially tragic consequences.
