1. FOLLOWING IS THE TEXT OF OPENING STATEMENT AND OTHER REMARKS MADE BY US AMBASSADOR TO FRANCE JOE M. RODGERS AT A PRESS CONFERENCE AT THE AMERICAN EMBASSY IN PARIS, FEBRUARY 28, AFTER A FRENCH COURT CONVICTED TERRORIST GEORGES IBRAHIM ABDALLAH TO A LIFE SENTENCE FOR COMPLICITY IN THE MURDERS OF TWO DIPLOMATS, ONE OF THEM AMERICAN LIEUTENANT COLONEL CHARLES RAY, AND THE ATTEMPTED ASSASSINATION OF ANOTHER US DIPLOMAT. ROBERT

HOMME.

---OPENING STATEMENT---

"THE UNITED STATES GOVERNMENT IS PLEASED THAT GEORGE IBRAHIM ABDALLAH WAS TRIED AND CONVICTED FOR COMPLICITY IN THE ASSASSINATION OF LT. COL. CHARLES RAY AND THE ATTEMPTED ASSASSINATION OF CONSUL GENERAL ROBERT BY JOINING AS PARTIE CIVILE, THE UNITED STATES HOMME. SOUGHT JUSTICE FOR OFFICIAL REPRESENTATIVES SERVING IN FRANCE WHO WERE VICTIMS OF THESE TERRORIST ACTIONS. SOUGHT AS WELL TO UNDERLINE OUR COMMITMENT TO THE STRUGGLE AGAINST INTERNATIONAL TERRORISM AND TO THE RULE OF LAW HICH SERVES CIVILIZATION AS ITS ULTIMATE AND MOST APPROPRIATE DEFENSE AGAINST THE RAVAGES OF THOSE WHO VIOLATE ITS MOST SACRED PRINCIPLES OF WHICH THE FIRST IS 'THOU SHALL NOT KILL.' THE UNITED STATES GOVERNMENT, THEREFORE, WELCOMES THE DECISION BY THE SPECIAL FRENCH COURT. WHAT WE SOUGHT

DECISION BY THE SPECIAL FRENCH COURT. WHAT WE SOUGHT IN THIS TRIAL WAS JUSTICE AND JUSTICE HAS BEEN RENDERED.

2. FOLLOWING IS THE VERBATIM TRANSCRIPT OF THE REST OF THE PRESS CONFERENCE IN WHICH THE US LAWYER IN THE ABDALLAH CASE, GEORGES KIEJMAN, PARTICIPATED ALONG WITH

AMBASSADOR RODGERS:

- Q. (PARTIALLY INAUDIBLE QUESTION ON THE LIKELY EFFECT ON THE FRENCH HOSTAGES IN LEBANON OF THIS DECISION.) RODGERS: IN THE DEFENSE OF DEMOCRACY WE NEED TO TAKE A STAND. I AM VERY PROUD OF THE FRENCH GOVERNMENT TODAY FOR TAKING A STAND IN DEFENSE OF DEMOCRACY. E WILL HAVE TO WORRY ABOUT THE OUTCOME OF THIS LATER AND WE MUST FACE THE CONSEQUENCES OF DEFENDING DEMOCRACY JUST AS WE DID DURING OUR WORLD WARS AND IN OTHER WAYS. WE ARE AT WAR AND WE ARE DEFENDING DEMOCRACY.
- Q. (QUESTION OF THE APPROPRIATENESS OF THE USG MAKING PULBIC COMMENTS ABOUT A FRENCH LEGAL ACTION NOW OR AS IT DID LAST JULY.)
- A. WELL, FIRST, THANKS TO THE FRENCH JUDICIAL SYSTEM, WE WERE ALLOWED TO PARTICIPATE IN THIS TRIAL AS A PARTIE CIVILE. WE APPRECIATED THAT OPPORTUNITY AND, THROUGH OUR ATTORNEY, WHO DID AN OUTSTANDING JOB, WE WERE REPRESENTED IN THIS COURT IN THE PROPER MANNER OF THE FRENCH JUDICIAL SYSTEM. SO, NO, WE ARE NOT INTERFERRING IN ANY WAY IN THE FRENCH JUDICIAL SYSTEM. WE AVOIDED MAKING ANY COMMENT DURING THIS TRIAL, BUT WE WERE REPRESENTED BY OUR ATTORNEY, AND THROUGH OUR ATTORNEY, AS PARTIE CIVILE. SO WE ARE PLEASED THAT WE WERE ALLOWED TO DO THAT. WE FEEL DUE PROCESS HAS BEEN DONE. WE ASKED FOR JUSTICE "ET LA JUSTICE A ETE RENDUE."
- Q. (QUESTION ABOUT WHAT THE USG WOULD HAVE SAID IF ABDALLAH HAD BEEN ACQUITTED.)
- A. WELL, I DONT'T THINK HE SHOULD TALK ABOUT "WHAT IF." AGAIN, WE ASKED THAT DUE PROCESS BE GIVEN, THAT JUSTICE BE DEMANDED, AND WE FEEL VERY GOOD THAT DUE PROCESS WAS GIVEN.
- Q. (QUESTION WHETHER THE AMBASSADOR WOULD CRITICIZE THE PERFORMANCE OF THE PROSECUTOR IN THE TRIAL WHO, YESTERDAY, CALLED FOR ABDALLAH TO BE GIVEN A LIGHT SENTENCE.)
- A. JUSTICE WAS RENDERED--THAT'S MY TOTAL COMMENT. THE BT

- Q. (QUESTION WHETHER STATEMENTS MADE BY THE EMBASSY LAST JULY AND AGAIN TODAY WERE NOT ACTUALLY AN INTERFERENCE IN FRENCH INTERNAL AFFAIRS.)
- A. YOU MAY BE SURE THAT THE STATEMENT THIS EMBASSY MADE IN THE LYON CASE WAS NOT INTERFERING. IN OUR OPINION, IN THE FRENCH LEGAL SYSTEM, WE HAVE BEEN VERY CAREFUL NOT TO DO THAT. THE FRENCH JUDICIAL SYSTEM IS THEIR SYSTEM AND WE ARE STAYING OUT OF IT. I AM SURE WE WOULD HAVE HAD A PRESS CONFERENCE NO MATTER WHAT THE RESULTS OF THIS TRIAL HAD BEEN. BUT AGAIN I SAY THERE'S NO USE IN TALKING ABOUT WHAT IF, BECAUSE IT DIDN'T HAPPEN. WHAT HAPPENED IS THAT JUSTICE WAS RENDERED.
- Q. (QUESTION ABOUT ALLEGED INCONSISTENCY IN THE AMERICAN POSITION WITH THE USG "PRESSURING" FRAMCE TO BE TOUGH WITH TERRORISTS AT THE SAME TIME IN "IRANGATE" THE US WAS ATTEMPTING TO TRADE ARMS FOR HOSTAGES.)
 A. WELL, ABOUT PUSHING THE FRENCH GOVERNMENT—WE DIDN'T PUSH THE FRENCH GOVERNMENT. THE FRENCH GOVERNMENT USED ITS SYSTEM TO TRY A PERSON FOR COMPLICITY IN MURDER. AND A JUDGE, A SPECIAL JUDGE AND TRIBUNAL FOUND HIM GUILTY. SO WE DID NOT PUSH THE FRENCH GOVERNMENT IN ANY WAY. WE WERE ALLOWED TO BE REPRESENTED IN COURT AS A PARTIE CIVILE. OUR ATTORNEY WAS ALLOWED TO GET ALL THE EVIDENCE OUT AND INTO THE COURT, AND WE APPRECIATE THAT.
- Q. (ANOTHER QUESTION ON AMERICAN ARMS SALES TO IRAN.)
 A. AGAIN, I ANSWERED THAT BY SAYING THAT FRANCE JUST
 USED ITS JUDICIAL SYSTEM TO TRY A CRIMINAL. THEY TRIED
 A CRIMINAL AND FOUND HIM GUILTY. THAT HAS NOTHING TO
 DO WITH OUR POLICY IN IRAN. THEY USED THEIR JUDICIAL
 SYSTEM TO TRY A CRIMINAL AND CONVICT HIM.

- A. WELL, WE ARE HERE TO ANSWER QUESTIONS BY THE NEWS MEDIA, AND WE ARE DOING THAT. IF IT VIOLATES ANY FRENCH LAW, IT IS NOT ONE THAT I KNOW OF.
- Q. (FOLLOW-UP QUESTION ON SAME SUBJECT.)
 RODGERS: WE SHOULDN'T ALWAYS TRY TO FIND WAYS TO CAUSE
 TROUBLE BETWEEN OUR TWO COUNTRIES, WHICH IS WHAT THE
 TONE OF THESE QUESTIONS HAVE BEEN. WE NEED TO BE VERY
 PLEASED BY THE FACT THAT JUSTICE HAS BEEN DONE TODAY.
 WE WERE ALLOWED TO PARTICIPATE AS PARTIE CIVILE IN YOUR
 JUDICIAL SYSTEM. WE NEVER INTERFERED IN THAT SYSTEM.
