Development of the Hizballah Strategy in South Lebanon (U)

(S/NF) The Hizballah (Party of God) has proclaimed its intention to create an Islamic republic in Lebanon along the lines of the Islamic Republic of Iran. Initial efforts were first evidenced in the Bekaa Valley and southern suburbs of West Beirut. In the past year, the Hizballah has increasingly directed its attention and energies toward predominantly Shi'a-populated south Lebanon, developing a clear strategy aimed at eliminating Israeli and Lebanese Christian presence in that area.

-(S/NF)-South Lebanon is the heartland of Lebanon's Shi'a community and the Hizballah is in competition with the Amal Movement for constituents in the region. The Hizballah also finds itself at odds with Amal's fight against the Palestinians in the "camps war." The Hizballah, believing that the camps war detracts from the primary goal of confronting Israel, openly seeks to resolve the conflict and to redirect Palestinian and Amal forces toward operations against Israel.

-(S/NF)-Amal, Israeli, and Army of South Lebanon (ASL) attempts to resist the Hizballah inroads into southern Lebanon, on both military and propoganda terms, have been unsuccessful. The Hizballah efforts to harass Israeli/ASL positions have received increased support among the Shi'a population, forcing Amal to reluctantly increase its support for the Hizballah's strategic plans.

(S/NF). The Hizballah attacks are occurring with greater frequency and have visibly demoralized and deteriorated the ASL and bolstered the Shi'a population's will to resist foreign occupation. Unless a successful military or political response to the gains of the Hizballah is implemented, much of south Lebanon may eventually become a fundamentalist Islamic canton in and of itself.

#### Strategic Importance of South Lebanon


(S/NF) The Hizballah (Party of God) leadership has repeatedly proclaimed its intention to create an Islamic republic in Lebanon modeled upon the Islamic Republic of Iran. Hizballah is a religiously motivated party which portrays itself as representing all Muslims, but its roots are clearly Shi'a and the Iranian influence in its teachings is strong. One of the party's primary goals is to replace the Amal Movement as the major spokesman for the Shi'a Muslim community — the most populous and least privileged sect to emerge over the past decade as an instrumental force in Lebanon's volatile political arena.


-(S/NF) The Iranian leader, Ayatollah Ruhollah Khomeini, is considered the supreme commander of the Hizballah movement and his views are translated into guidance and instructions by Iran's Supreme Defense Council. Policies pertaining to Lebanon are then sent to either the Iranian Ambassador in Damascus or the Iranian Revolutionary Guards Corps (IRGC) contingent in Lebanon. Iran established and continues to sponsor the Lebanese Consultative Council in an attempt to better coordinate its policy in Lebanon. Inside Lebanon, Shaykh Muhammad Husayn Fadlallah is considered the spiritual leader of the Hizballah, while its military operations are normally supervised by the IRGC.

Prospects for the Future

(S/NF) The potential for the Hizballah's dominance in south Lebanon is high. Neither Israel nor the ASL has been able to adequately deter the Hizballah attacks or to extract a prohibitive price from the Hizballah for its recent boldness. At the same time, the ASL is becoming increasingly demoralized and more dependent upon Israeli military support; i.e., airstrikes and artillery bombardments. This has helped to increase the Hizballah's stature among the Shi'a population at the expense of the Amal, who are frustrated by their lack of success in the camps war against the Palestinians. In order to stem the tide of Hizballah's success, movement

of the Hizballah forces from the Bekaa to south Lebanon must be controlled. This may include Israeli military operations outside of the Security Zone and possibly into the heart of the Bekaa Valley, which could prove quite costly and probably would be challenged by Syrian forces stationed in that part of Lebanon.

(S/NF) While the Hizballah's achievements appear to have influenced its efforts in gaining ground in south Lebanon, Israel contends that the Hizballah still plays a limited role in the region. Its growth is attributed more to its financial resources and less to its ideological appeal among the poor, Shi'a community. Its weakness is that it focuses on the religious dimension and neglects the social aspects of society, something Amal doctrine emphasizes.

-(S/NF)-The Hizballah can be expected to continue to mount hit-and-run attacks throughout south Lebanon at periodic intervals depending upon its ability to stockpile supplies and replenish existing caches. The Hizballah leadership has stated its acceptance of probable high casualty rates in its determination to implement its political plans throughout Lebanon.

(S/NF) The Hizballah will continue to emphasize that it is properly focused on actions against the occupying forces of Israel and its surrogate, the ASL, while belittling the Amal tendency to pursue an inter-Arab struggle with the Palestinian militias. Whether this will significantly influence the local populace remains to be seen. Syria will most likely increase its military and political support to the Amal to counter the Hizballah gains, particularly since the Hizballah efforts run counter to Syrian interests in Lebanon. Whether either Israel with the ASL or Syria with the Amal shows enough determination to halt Hizballah's growing presence in south Lebanon will greatly affect how successful Hizballah military and political strategies are in the region.

THE LIBERIA HIZBALLAH ORGANIZATION HAS BEEN GRANTED APPROVAL BY LEBANESE COMMUNITY PRESIDENT ABBAS ((FAWAZ)) AND THE LIBERIAN GOVERNMENT TO OPEN A CULTURAL CENTER TO BE CALLED THE ISLAMIC ASSOCIATION OF LIBERTA (IAL). FAWAZ DOES NOT SUPPORT THE INCREASING HIZBALLAH INFLUENCE IN THE LEBANESE COMMUNITY, BUT CAN NO LONGER DENY HIZBALLAH THE RIGHT TO PURSUE ITS RELIGIOUS AND POLITICAL GOALS IN LIBERIA. - 4. THE FUNDS TO CONSTRUCT OFFICES FOR THE IAL WERE SOLICITED BECAUSE HIZBALLAH PLANS TO USE THE IAL AS A COVER FOR ITS RECRUITMENT ACTIVITIES. HIZBALLAH'S LONG-TERM GOAL IS TO DEVELOP A CADRE OF GOOD LIBERIAN MUSLIMS (SIC) WHO ARE LOYAL TO HIZBALLAH AND IRANIAN LEADER AYATOLLAH ((KHOMEINI)). PRIORITY IS TO BE GIVEN TO DEVELOPING GUALITY LIBERIAN HIZBALLAH MEMBERS RATHER THAN SIMPLY RECRUITING AS MANY LIBERIANS AS POSSIBLE TO HIZBALLAH. IN THE SHORT TERM, HIZBALLAH WILL INTENSIFY ITS RECRUITMENT EFFORTS AMONG THE LEBANESE COMMUNITY IN ORDER TO STRENGTHEN THE RECRUITING AND TRAINING ASPECTS OF THE LIBERIA HIZBALLAH ORGANIZATION. HIZBALLAH WILL THEN BEGIN ENTICING LIBERIAN MUSLIMS TO JOIN THE IAL, SELECTING THE MOST DEVOUT TO JOIN HIZBALLAH. THAT SAID, A DEVOTED HIZBALLAH FANATIC WILL USUALLY ATTEMPT ANY TASK ASSIGNED BY A SHAYKH AND, ASSUMING RECRUITS MEET THE DESIRED CRITERIA, HIZBALLAH MEMBERS IN LIBERIA WOULD BE NO EXCEPTION. 2. SUMMARY: A GERMAN DIPLOMAT TELLS US THAT THERE IS ABSOLUTELY NO MOVEMENT AT THE MOMENT ON THE RELEASE OF THE SECOND GERMAN HOSTAGE. ALTHOUGH SYRIA AND IRAN SEEM TO BE WORKING TOGETHER WELL TO EFFECT CORDES' RELEASE, THE HIZBALLAH KIDNAPPERS ARE NOW INSISTING ON A GUARANTEE FOR THE HAMADI BROTHERS' EARLY RELEASE—ASSURANCES BONN REFUSES TO GIVE. NEVERTHELESS, THE

OPTIMISTIC THAT CORDES WILL BE RELEASED SOON. END SUMMARY.

3. POLCOUNS MET WITH THE HEAD OF THE POLITICAL SECTION OF THE WEST GERMAN EMBASSY IN DAMASCUS, SEPTEMBER 22. THE GERMAN DIPLOMAT,

SAID THAT THE PROCESS FOR RELEASING THE SECOND GERMAN HOSTAGE, RUDOLF CORDES, HAS COME TO A COMPLETE STOP. 

BALLOUT CITED "SECRET INFORMATION" FROM BEIRUT ABOUT IRAN'S EFFORT LATELY TO STRENGTHEN ITS CONTROL OVER THE ORGANIZATION BY HAVING "INDEPENDENT" MEMBERS REMOVED. BALLOUT MENTIONED TWO PROMINENT HITRALLAH FIGURES AS TARGETS OF THE IRANIAN CAMPAIGN: SHAIKH MOHAMED MAHDI SHAMS AL-DIN, CHAIRMAN OF THE SUPREME SHIA COUNCIL IN LEBANON, AND SPIRITUAL LEADER SHAIKH MOMANED MUSSEIN FADHLALLAH. IRAN OBJECTED TO THEM. ACCORDING TO THE ARTICLE, BECAUSE OF THEIR RESISTANCE TO THE KNOMEINI REGIME'S INSTRUCTIONS TO REPLICATE IRAN'S FADHLALLAH ARGUED THAT THE POLITICAL EVOLUTION OF LEBANON'S MUSLIM FUNDAMENTALIST MOVEMENT (SUNN! AS WELL AS SHIA) DIFFERED FROM THE IRANIAN EXPERIENCE BECAUSE OF THAT MOVEMENT'S "UNIQUE LEBANESE CHARACTERISTICS."
- 3. WI IN THE "COUP O'ETAT," WROTE BALLOUT, SHAIKH SUBHI AL-TAFILI EMERGED AS HIZBALLAN'S "ACTUAL LEADER," WHO WAS NOW SETTING THE ORGANIZATION'S POLICY IN MONTHLY MEETINGS AT THE "SHAIKH ABDULLAH ARMY CAMP" IN BAALBEK. OTHER ATTENDEES AT THESE GATHERINGS INCLUDED THE IRANIAN AMBASSADOR TO LEBANON, THE IRANIAN REVOLUTIONARY GUARD OFFICIAL RESPONSIBLE FOR SYRIA AND LEBANON, HOUSTAFA KHAKSAR, HIS DEPUTY, MOHAMED AVAI, AND MUSLIM BROTHERHOOD

OFFICIALS. THE BASIC PURPOSE OF THESE MEETINGS WAS TO PLOT A STRATEGY FOR ACCELERATING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF LEBANON'S ISLAMIC REPUBLIC, TO BE BASED INITIALLY IN BAALBEK AND THEN EXPANDED VIA THE "LIBERATION" OF THE COUNTRY'S OTHER REGIONS. ON THE MUSLIM BROTHERHOOD'S REPRESENTATION, BALLOUT SPOKE OF ITS "INTENSIVE COOPERATION" WITH HIZBALLAH AND ATTRIBUTED THE CLOSE LINKS TO IRAN'S PROMOTION OF AN ISLAMIC REPUBLIC IN LEBANON THAT WOULD ENJOY BROAD-BASED SUNNI, AS WELL AS SHIA SUPPORT.

- 4. WE BALLOUT STATED THAT IRAN'S REVOLUTIONARY GUARDS HAD ENJOYED "ABSOLUTE CONTROL" DVER HIZBALLAH SINCE LAST MAY, WHEN THEY INSTALLED IRANIANS THROUGHOUT THE ORGANIZATION'S HIERARCHY. HE ADDED THAT, UNDER THE "TOTAL MILITARY MOBILIZATION" RECENTLY DECREED TO HIZBALLAH MEMBERS, THEY WERE UNDERGOING INTENSIFIED TRAINING AT CAMPS IN THE BEKAA AREA.
- DISCUSSING IRAN'S MOVES TO CREATE THE "ECONDMIC BASE" FOR ITS LEBANESE OFFSHOOT, BALLOUT SAID THAT AS OF LAST MAY, TEHRAN HAD SHARPLY INCREASED ITS FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO HIZBALLAH AND TO THE BAALBEK AREA GENERALLY. OVER THE MAY/SEPTEMBER PERIOD, THE INCREASE AMOUNTED TO DOLS 5 MILLION, COMPARED WITH PREVIOUS AID LEVELS. THE ADOITIONAL MONEY WAS USED TO FINANCE PUBLIC HEALTH, AGRICULTURAL, AND OTHER DEVELOPMENTAL PROJECTS, AS WELL AS HILITARY OPERATIONS IN SOUTHERN LEBANON AGAINST ISRAELI AND SLA FORCES AND "SALARY" HIKES OF 20 TO 50 PERCENT FOR HIZBALLAH CADRES.

INVESTIGATING MAGISTRATE BOULOUQUE IS INCREASINGLY CONVINCED THAT THE SAME HIZBALLAH "CELL" WAS BEHIND THE 1986 CSPPA BOMBINGS IN PARIS, THE HAMMADI BROTHERS' ATTEMPTS TO BRING EXPLOSIVES INTO WEST GERMANY, THE HIJACKING OF TWA #847 IN 1985, THE ARREST OF BASHIR KHODR IN ITALY, AND THE HOLDING OF WESTERN HOSTAGES IN LEBANON. BOULOUQUE STATED THAT HIS DECISION TO RELEASE MUHAMMAD MUHADJER WAS BASED PURELY ON A LACK OF HARD EVIDENCE RATHER THAN ON ANY GOF NEGOTIATIONS FOR THE RELEASE OF HOSTAGES. 

KHODR'S ADDRESS BOOK CONTAINED DETAILED INFORMATION ON HOW TO CONTACT HASSAN GHOSN.
- 10. AS REPORTED IN REFTEL, ALSO ENABLED BOULOUQUE TO IDENTIFY ANOTHER MEMBER OF THE PARIS NETWORK WHO HAD TRAVELED TO FRANCE IN 1986 USING THE PASSPORT OF ALI GHOSN. (THE REAL ALI GHOSN, A BROTHER OF HASSAN GHOSN, IS MENTALLY AND PHYSICALLY RETARDED AND CANNOT TRAVEL.)

  IDENTIFIED THIS INDIVIDUAL AS HASSAN IZZ-AL-DIN, ONE OF HAMMADI'S ACCOMPLICES IN THE TWA HIJACKING, WHO OPERATES IN WEST BEIRUT UNDER THE CODE NAME "TAHSIN". IZZ-AL-DIN, AGAIN USING ALI GHOSN'S IDENTITY, WAS ALSO AMONG THOSE HIZBALLAH MEMBERS---INCLUDING HASSAN GHOSN, HUSSEIN MASBU, ALI HASSAN, AND ALI ATEF ALA-AL-DIN---ARRESTED AND EXPELLED FROM FRANCE IN FEBRUARY 1986.

MUHADJER'S RELEASE UNRELATED TO HOSTAGE NEGOTIATIONS

- 11. POLOFF ASKED BOULOUQUE WHY HE HAD DECIDED TO RELEASE SUSPECTED HIZBALLAH MEMBER MUHAMMAD MUHADJER. THE MAGISTRATE INSISTED THAT THE RELEASE WAS DUE SOLELY TO A LACK OF HARD EVIDENCE. HE POINTED OUT THAT HE HAD KEPT MUHADJER UNDER DETENTION FOR A FULL YEAR ON THE GROUNDS THAT THE LATTER HAD BEEN IN CONTACT WITH FUAD SALAH, ALI ALA-AL-DIN, AND IRANIAN EMBASSY EMPLOYEE WAHID GORJI, BUT THERE WAS NO ACTUAL EVIDENCE LINKING MUHADJER TO THE CSPPA BOMBINGS. BOULOUQUE STATED THAT MUHADJER HAD ALMOST CERTAINLY WORKED AS AN IRANIAN "INTELLIGENCE AGENT" BUT MAY NOT HAVE BEEN INVOLVED WITH THE TERRORIST OPERATIONS.
- 12. THE MAGISTRATE VEHEMENTLY CRITICIZED THE PRESS FOR HAVING ACCUSED HIM OF RELEASING MUHADJER AS PART S E C R E T SECTION 03 OF 03 PARIS 13966

SUBJECT: DEVELOPMENTS IN FRENCH INVESTIGATION INTO OF A NEGOTIATED DEAL BETWEEN THE GOF AND TEHERAN FOR THE LIBERATION OF FRENCH HOSTAGES IN LEBANON.
BOULOUQUE DENIED ANY SUCH "TRACTATIONS" AND REMINDED POLOFF THAT HE HAD TOLD AMBASSADOR BREMER IN EARLY MARCH THAT THE CASE AGAINST MUHADJER WAS WEAK. AS FURTHER PROOF THAT THERE IS NO GOF "DEAL", BOULOUQUE NOTED THAT THE STATE PROSECUTOR'S OFFICE VIGOROUSLY OPPOSED BOULOUQUE'S DECISION AND IS IN THE PROCESS OF APPEALING IT. (COMMENT: CHIEF PROSECUTOR ALAIN MARSAUD HAS CONFIRMED THIS SEPARATELY TO US.)

13. POLOFF ASKED BOULOUQUE WHY CERTAIN GOF OFFICIALS WERE SAYING THAT MUHADJER WAS RELEASED BECAUSE HE HAD PROVIDED IMPORTANT ASSISTANCE IN THE INVESTIGATION INTO THE HIZBALLAH NETWORK. BOULOUQUE ADMITTED THAT HE WAS BAFFLED BY THESE REMARKS, CONSIDERING THAT MUHADJER HAD BEEN RELATIVELY UNCOOPERATIVE. HE SPECULATED THAT THESE GOF OFFICIALS WERE MERELY TRYING TO DEFLECT ACCUSATIONS THAT BOULOUQUE'S DECISION WAS LINKED TO HOSTAGE NEGOTIATIONS.

#### INVESTIGATION REVEALS NEW NAMES

14. BOULOUQUE MENTIONED THAT THREE NEW NAMES HAVE RECENTLY COME UP IN THE INVESTIGATION. ONE IS FAROUK MASBU, WHO IS THE BROTHER OF HUSSEIN MASBU (SEE PARAGRAPH 10 ABOVE). FAROUK MASBU IS REPUTEDLY A LARGE-SCALE DRUG TRAFFICKER IN THE BEKAA VALLEY WHO HELPS FINANCE HIZBALLAH OPERATIONS. ANOTHER NEW NAME IS ABBAS NASRALLAH, A LEBANESE WHO TRIED TO TAKE DELIVERY OF THE PRINTING ROLLERS——WHICH ACTUALLY CONTAINED EXPLOSIVES——THAT HAD BEEN SHIPPED FROM BEIRUT TO A PARIS AIRPORT IN NOVEMBER 1986. FINALLY, BOULOUQUE HAS LEARNED THAT THE INDIVIDUAL WHO SHIPPED THE PRINTING ROLLERS FROM BEIRUT WAS HUSSIN JAFAAR.

- 15. BOULOUQUE ASKED IF THE USG CAN PROVIDE HIM WITH ANY INFORMATION ON THESE THREE INDIVIDUALS---FAROUK MASBU, ABBAS NASRALLAH, OR HUSSEIN JAFAAR---OR FOR THAT MATTER ON ANY OF THE OTHER HIZBALLAH MEMBERS IDENTIFIED IN BOULOUQUE'S INVESTIGATION. PLEASE INFORM.
