BONN, WEST GERMANY (UPI) THE GOVERNMENT, RESPONDING TO REPORTS IT PLANS TO SWAP TWO LEBANESE BROTHERS FOR TWO GERMAN HOSTAGES IN LEBANON, SAID TUESDAY IT IS STILL REVIEWING A U.S. REQUEST TO EXTRADITE ONE ARAB TO FACE HIJACKING CHARGES.

'NOTHING HAS CHANGED,' SAID JUSTICE MINISTRY SPOKESMAN JUERGEN SCHMID. 'THE EXTRADITION REQUEST IS STILL BEING CAREFULLY REVIEWED.' GOVERNMENT SPOKESMAN JUERGEN FINDEISEN ALSO SAID THE REQUEST 'IS BEING REVIEWED.'

NBC REPORTED MONDAY EVENING IT HAD CONFIRMATION FROM THE JUSTICE DEPARTMENT IN WASHINGTON THAT THE WEST GERMAN GOVERNMENT WAS CONSIDERING A SWAP TO WIN THE FREEDOM OF TWO WEST GERMAN BUSINESSMEN SEIZED TO EXTORT THE RELEASE OF ACCUSED TWA HIJACKER MOHAMMAD ALI HAMADEI.

ALSO ON MONDAY, THE BILD NEWSPAPER REPORTED THE WEST GERMAN GOVERNMENT PLANNED TO WIN THE FREEDOM OF THE HOSTAGES BY FIRST TRYING, AND THEN EXPELLING, HAMADEI AND HIS BROTHER.

HAMADEI, 22, WAS ARRESTED AT FRANKFURT AIRPORT ON JAN. 13 AND IS BEING HELD FOR EXTRADITION TO THE UNITED STATES TO FACE CHARGES IN THE 1985 17-DAY HIJACKING OF A TWA JETLINER FROM ATHENS TO BEIRUT IN WHICH A NAVY DIVER WAS KILLED.

HIS BROTHER, ALI ABBAS HAMADEI, 28, WAS ARRESTED ON HIS ARRIVAL IN FRANKFURT FROM BEIRUT SHORTLY AFTER GERMANS ALFRED SCHMIDT AND RUDOLF CORDES WERE ABDUCTED IN MOSLEM WEST BEIRUT.

ANOTHER HAMADEI BROTHER IS KNOWN TO BE THE SECURITY CHIEF OF THE PRO-IRANIAN SHIITE MOSLEM GROUP HEZBOLLAH, OR PARTY OF GOD. THIS IS UNDERSTOOD TO BE THE GROUP HOLDING CORDES AND SCHMIDT HOSTAGE TO EXTORT THE RELEASE OF THE HAMADEI BROTHERS.

ALTHOUGH BONN GOVERNMENT SOURCES HINTED STRONGLY THAT THE HESSIAN STATE JUSTICE MINISTRY IN WIESBADEN WAS NOW INVOLVED IN THE HAMADEI EXTRADITION DELIBERATIONS, A SPOKESMAN FOR THE STATE JUSTICE MINISTER DECLINED COMMENT.

THE STATE OF HESSE HAS CRIMINAL JURISDICTION IN FRANKFURT WHERE THE HAMADEI BROTHERS ARE BEING HELD.
