## U.S. Rights Unit Blasts Reagan **Over Education**

The U.S. Commission on Civil Rights de-nounced the Reggin administration's educa-tion policies yesterday, charging that its op-position to forced busing and the efforts to make deep cuts in aid could mean the return of separate and inequal public sensors for-minorities.

In a statement on school desegregation, the commission accused the Justice Department of opposing the most effective remedy for desegregating the public schools—the mandatory reassignment of students—and the most effective tool for implementing this remedy—student fransportation.

It charged that the Justice Department, by support it charged that the usuce bepartment, by supporting "voluntary methods of desegregation which over time have proved ineffective, would have the nation return to pre-1954 standards ... (and) revert to the separate and unequal blot that has stained our nation's credo of equal fustice under law."

The Justice Department is obstructing our national policy to achieve school desegregation. Commissioner Mirray Saltzman, a Baltimore rabbi, said at a news conference.

In a separate report, the six-member, panel or cized President Reagan's largely unsuccessful attem to cut more than 44 billion from aid to schools a college students in fiscal 1985, it said the cuts wol "undermine the fragile gains made by the least pri leged in our society."

The commission said Reagan's proposed education

into block grants would "substantially diminish, the
dominant role of the federal government in helping to
ensure equal opportunity."

Aine Graham, the Education Department's assistant secretary for legislation and public affairs, replied: This idministration continues to oppose the failed social policy of forced busing, as does over 70 percent of the American, public. She said the block grant approach gives states "greater flexibility in the use of federal funds and delivers more educational opportunity to America's students."

Commissiones Mary Frances Berry, a professor of law and history at Howard University and former top education official under President Carter, said the Reagan administration "has demonstrated a complete lack of support both for quality (education) and for desegregation."


