Dear Mr. Campbell:

The President will soon appoint an Advisory Council on Private Sector Initiatives to continue the work begun last year by his Task Force. One of their focuses will be to ease the plight of displaced workers by encouraging the creation of job search clubs in a limited number of plants around the country.

The model they plan to follow was established at the Crucible Steel Company in Midland, Pennsylvania. I mention that because EDA funded a study of the Crucible Steel Job Search Club through the Commerce Department's Office of Productivity, Technology, and Innovation. I understand that Egils Milberg and Paul Braden of that office were most impressed with the results of the program. Therefore, plans are being made to replicate that example through the Private Sector Initiatives Advisory Council, and it is in that regard that your help is needed.

Although job search clubs will be underwritten primarily by management and labor, it will be necessary to send limited technical assistance to the participating plants to get the program started. They plan to use the same technical experts who worked on the Crucible Steel project and would like for you to consider funding them.

I am told that a proposal to that effect is on its way to you, and I urge you to give it careful consideration.

Few, if any programs are as important to the President as Private Sector Initiatives, and I hope you will be able to assist the Advisory Council in this endeavor.

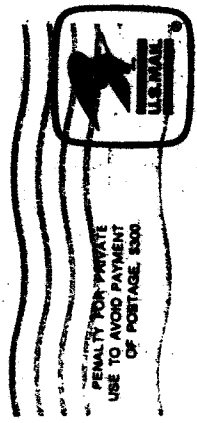

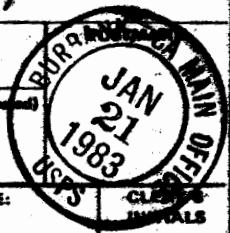

As you know, HRH The Duke of Edinburgh will be accompanying The Queen on almost all her engagements during their forthcoming visit to the West Coast. The only occasions on which the Duke of Edinburgh will be carrying out separate engagements are on the afternoon of Saturday, 26 February and on the afternoon of Monday, 28 February.

Given that the Duke will otherwise be with The Queen throughout, I am writing to ask whether it will be possible for him to have Secret Service protection, not just when he is with The Queen, but when he undertakes these limited separate engagements. I think that this would be simpler administratively and, I hope, more convenient for all concerned.

After conferring with our good friend Joe Rodgers, I write this letter to request your consideration of an invitation to the President.
