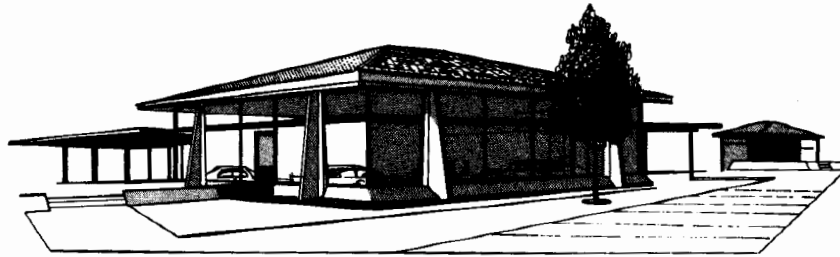

Your appearance on stage as a singer in a skit was unprecedented in the 98 years of the club. President Nixon played the piano in an afterpiece. Mrs. Ford danced. President and Mrs. Carter jitterbugged, yes they did. And, of course, Mrs. Reagan sang, stole a whole show, and set the standard for you.

Your performance--obviously a triumph--will be in the history books. I will remember as well your modesty, courtesy and plain nervousness at our rehearsal. 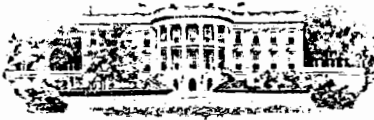
