SUBJECT:

Amway Gift

By your memorandum of December 22, 1982 you requested our advice regarding proper disposition of the gift of certain Amway products received by Mr. Deaver from John Gartland of the Amway Corporation. You indicated that Mr. Deaver has no desire to retain the gift.

It is our opinion that despite the appraised \$40 retail value of the gift (which, as you know, consists of powder, body cream, bath soap, etc.), it can be viewed, considering its donor, as an "advertising or promotional" item, receipt of which is not prohibited by Executive Order 11222 or the White House Standards of Conduct (3 C.F.R. 100.735-14).

In view of Mr. Deaver's desire not to retain the gift, there are two options under these circumstances. First, Mike can acknowledge and thank the donor for the gift but designate on our gift form that it be turned over to the government. Alternatively despite the fact that the gift is not strictly prohibited, it can be returned to the donor with a short note, a proposed draft of which we have attached.

Either disposition protects Mr. Deaver from any conflict or appearance thereof. Please notify me of his preference and I will complete the gift form accordingly.


