It caused quite a stir up in our little  
village post office (we have no house numbers  
or mail delivery) which is a community meeting  
place each day. Please tell the Reagans we  
will treasure it always and have it in a  
lovely desk frame. It will enhance our Arizona  
home when we move.

Last Sunday, I watched Secretary James Watt  
being grilled on TV and found him very courageous  
and making good sense. He is the great  
answer to all the "bleeding heart" conservationists  
around (most of whom don't own property) and  
who would have the federal government take



over our Big Sur Coast. Cranston, Panetta and  
Amed Adams tried, but failed when Senator Sam  
stopped a sneaky bill of Cranston. There is a way  
for Secretary Leath to put another feather in his  
cap - this is just our suggestion - and that is  
to get our Great little Southern Sea Otters back  
on the endangered species list. There are so  
few around. The fishermen shoot them and they have  
been drowning at an alarming rate in gill nets  
used by Vietnamese fishermen. David + Lucile  
Packard Foundation funds is building a terrific  
"Monterey Bay Aquarium", directed by their daughter  
Julie Packard, and housing an otter tank. "Sea  
World" in San Diego exhibit sea otters as well as the  
Seattle Aquarium. People from all over the world  
come to view our sea otters off Cannery Row in  
the help beds and my husband has the best drawings  
available. Many Marine Biologists use them in  
their lectures and publications. Have you ever seen  
Jacques Cousteau's TV picture of "The Unsinkable  
Sea Otters? The Queen and Prince Philip might  
enjoy anchoring in Monterey Harbor to see the  
otters when they visit in March - perhaps have  
lunch at the beautiful Cypress Point Club? The

Princess is connected with a world wildlife cause. He  
and The Queen would adore the little sea clowns.  
Enclosed are signed Royal prints to show to  
Secretary Watters, The President, etc. or you may  
give them to your two lovely children whom  
we saw on TV at a White House Gala before  
Christmas.

Andrew and I thank you again for the  
lovely Reagan Christmas Card and for the superb  
job you are doing for the greatest President to  
sit in the White House in this century. May  
God Bless you all -

Dear Mr. Deaver:

Please allow me to introduce you to a friend and colleague of mine who clearly represents the President's convictions that the spirit of private voluntary charity is alive and well in America.

During the 1960's, Dr. Kenneth Taylor, of Wheaton, Illinois, a godly father of ten children and a man of meager income, paraphrased the Bible into an easy to read version, currently known as the Living Bible. In just over ten years, it has sold almost 28 million copies. One out of every seven Americans owns a copy of the English Living Bible.

The unprecedented sales of the Living Bible made Dr. Taylor a wealthy man in a matter of months...at least he could have been wealthy. But Dr. Taylor decided that since it was the Word of God, he would not personally profit from the royalties. He immediately established the Tyndale House Foundation, and to date has given away all of the royalty monies from the Living Bible, well over \$22 million. Dr. Taylor continues to live in a small home, at a very modest standard of living. Each of his ten children have worked to pay their way through college.

Since 1968, Dr. Taylor has added an international dimension to his ministry, through Living Bibles International. His goal is to translate and print easy to read Bibles in 185 major foreign languages by 1992. These 185 languages reach 90% of the world's population. LBI currently employs 1100 staff people in 70 countries working on 100 different translations. Forty New Testaments and six complete Bibles have been translated and printed since 1968. Most of these 1100 staff are nationals, working in their own languages, in their own countries. Total circulation of the Living Bible in all languages now reaches close to 40 million copies.


Dr. Taylor is to be honored at the International Media Banquet, Sunday evening January 30, at the National Religious Broadcaster's Convention in Washington, D.C. We have heard through the grapevine that the President may be considering addressing the NRB delegates at this particular banquet.

We would like to arrange for Dr. Taylor to present the 28 millionth copy of the English Living Bible to the President at the NRB Convention. This would be especially appropriate since the NRB theme is "The Year of The Bible", and also since Dr. Taylor so clearly symbolizes the spirit of private charitable giving.

Let me assure you that the Living Bible is very broad in scope and should not create any religious/political liabilities for the President. We supply Bibles for Catholics and Protestants alike. Our Italian translation was recently printed on the Vatican Press; our English versions have widespread use and endorsement in both Protestant and Catholic groups in the U.S. Dr. Richard Halverson, Chaplain of the U.S. Senate is quite aware of our ministry and could give you an outside perspective. In 1974, Queen Elizabeth accepted a personalized copy of the Living Bible from Dr. Taylor.

I am aware that the President's plans for addressing the NRB delegates must necessarily remain tentative due to his schedule and security concerns. If there is any way that Dr. Taylor's presentation of the 28 millionth copy to the President can be arranged, I am ready to help in any way possible to facilitate these details.
