Staff Lapel Pins

1. The purpose of the "pin" is to allow access of required personnel into the concentric perimeter of protection provided the President.
  - a. This would include hotels, airports, receptions, rallies, etc.
2. Recommend:
  - a. The Secret Service issue and maintain the records of all pins.
  - b. The Military Office advise the USSS of the authority to issue based on our day to day working knowledge of all personnel that are involved in Presidential trips.
3. I would recommend that you identify the key White House travel staff to be issued the blue pin and not issue pins on the basis of rank as some would never be used in light of their purpose.
4. I recommend that you direct the various components of the White House to identify members of their respective staffs that would need the support (red) pins in order to gain access to secured areas during Presidential travel and outside appearances.
5. I recommend that you review and approve #4 based on your working knowledge of trip requirements.

For your information the attached list (III) is neither current nor accurate.
