SUBJECT: BUDGET/NICARAGUAN AID COMMUNICATIONS PLAN

Herewith is a Communications Plan for intensive Presidential involvement in <u>both</u> the Nicaraguan Aid and Budget debates. As we get two votes on Nicaragua, by April 30, and only the Senate vote on Budget, the early part of the program -- plus a Legislative Strategy recommended by Max's Shop -- focuses more heavily on Contra Aid, although there is a goodly amount of emphasis here on Budget as well.

Mike Deaver has generally approved all of the recommendations -with the exception of the Presidential Sunday Night Speech, April 21, on Nicaragua. His feeling is that the President ought not be empahsizing on national television an issue as negative and controversial as Contras. The Communications Group generally feels that an RR television speech is indispensable to victory, at least in the House.

(The Sunday before the Senate vote was selected to give the Nation the sense that the President triumphed again, when the Senate votes, and to thus build momentum for the House. However, if the President decides to go with the speech, the timing is certainly flexible.)

NOTE: There is some redundancy on the Budget Calendar. This simply means that an event can be dedicated to both causes. Will be home this evening if you want to discuss.


