MEMORANDUM

TO: Bill Benkel
FROM: Ron Fuller *RF*
SUBJECT: San Pedro Sula, Honduras - Logistical Constraints

Per our telephone conversation, I urge that the number of guests and staff traveling to San Pedro Sula be severely limited.

Although facilities for the bilaterals are adequate, holding rooms for combined U.S., Honduran and Guatemalan entourage are NOT. Overflow into outside route paths are likely.

Temperatures have been in the high 80's low 90's at the Air Base with high humidity. Air-conditioning, where it exists is poor.

We HAVE had rain during the time frame indicated for the visit on December 4.

I recommend that, at a minimum, the back-up and passengers remain in Costa Rica and arrive in this airspace to cover departure of Angel ONLY.
