I. PURPOSE

To review progress of Federal drug programs and to discuss future issues.

II. BACKGROUND

On March 27, 1987, you signed Executive Order 12590 establishing the NDPB. The Board combines the law enforcement responsibilities of the National Drug Enforcement Policy Board and the demand reduction role of the Domestic Policy Council.

You last met with the National Drug Enforcement Policy Board in April 1986. This meeting will provide an overview briefing of the Federal progress on reducing both the supply and demand of drugs.

In addition, there will be a discussion on future issues. Dr. Ian Macdonald will lead a discussion on the need to focus responsibilities for drug use on the individual user. Also, the issue of certifying drug-producing nations for continued foreign assistance will be discussed.

SUGGESTED TALKING POINTS FOR MEETING WITH
NATIONAL DRUG POLICY BOARD

July 23, 1987
