MEETING HELD AT 1100 HOURS (LOCAL), 1 SEPTEMBER 1981 AT PANMUNJOM.
I HAVE BEEN DIRECTED BY THE COMMANDER-IN-CHIEF, UNITED NATIONS
COMMAND, TO CALL THIS, THE 407TH MEETING OF THE MILITARY ARMISTICE
COMMISSION, FOR THE SOLE PURPOSE OF CHARGING YOUR SIDE WITH A PRE-
MEDITATED AND UNPROVOKED ACT OF AGGRESSION AGAINST THE UNC. THE
ACT WHICH YOUR SIDE COMMITTED IS OF SUCH MAGNITUDE AS TO SERIOUSLY
THREATEN THE PEACE ON THIS PENINSULA. IT STRIKES AGAINST THE VERY
HEART OF THE AA, AN AGREEMENT WHICH YOUR COMMANDER SIGNED AND IN
WHICH HE AGREED TO ORDER AND ENFORCE A COMPLETE CESSATION OF
HOSTILITIES IN KOREA.

ON 26 AUGUST 1981, YOUR SIDE ATTACKED WITH A SURFACE-TO-AIR
MISSILE A UNC UNARMED RECONNAISSANCE AIRCRAFT. OUR UNARMED AIRCRAFT
WAS ON A ROUTINE MISSION AND WAS INDISPUTABLY IN INTERNATIONAL
AIRSPACE BEFORE, DURING AND AFTER THE ATTACK. THE ATTACK MISSILE
WAS UNQUESTIONABLY LAUNCHED BY YOUR SIDE FROM NORTH KOREA. AT NO
TIME DID OUR AIRCRAFT DURING ITS FLIGHT ENTER YOUR SIDE'S LEGAL
AIR SPACE.

AT THIS MEETING, I WILL ADDRESS THIS ACT OF AGGRESSION ONLY. I
WILL NOT RESPOND TO YOUR USUAL LITANY OF FABRICATIONS AND ACCUSATIONS
ALL OF WHICH HAVE BEEN PROVED FALSE AND THOROUGHLY AND REPEATEDLY
REFUTED BY THE UNC IN THE PAST. LET ME STRONGLY EMPHASIZE THIS
LAST STATEMENT: I WILL NOT RESPOND TO YOUR PREDICTABLE PROPAGANDA
OR YOUR EXPECTED REJECTION OF OUR CHARGE AS FABRICATION.

I WILL NOW DESCRIBE THE INCIDENT IN DETAIL. AT 1634 HOURS, ON
26 AUGUST 1981, YOUR SIDE FIRED AN SA-2 SURFACE-TO-AIR MISSILE AT
OUR UNARMED RECONNAISSANCE AIRCRAFT, FROM YOUR SIDE'S MISSILE SITE
LOCATED HERE NEAR CHOKTA-RI. AT THIS TIME, OUR AIRCRAFT WAS LOCATED
ABOUT HERE, CLEARLY IN INTERNATIONAL AIRSPACE SOUTH OF THE UNC
CONTROLLED 5 ISLAND GROUPS.

AT 1635 HOURS, THE CREW OF THE UNARMED RECONNAISSANCE AIRCRAFT,
WHEN NEAR THIS LOCATION, AGAIN IN INTERNATIONAL AIRSPACE, CLEARLY
SAW A MISSILE CONTRAIL RISING FROM BELOW THEIR AIRCRAFT AND, ABOUT
30 SECONDS LATER, THE CREW OBSERVED THE MISSILE DETONATE ABOVE AND TO
THE REAR OF THE AIRCRAFT. AT THE TIME OF THE MISSILE DETONATION, OUR
UNARMED RECONNAISSANCE AIRCRAFT WAS STILL SOUTH OF THE UNC CONTROLLED
5 ISLAND GROUPS. I EMPHASIZE THIS LOCATION AS IT IS CLEARLY OVER
INTERNATIONAL WATERS AND OUR AIRCRAFT WAS OPERATING IN ACCORDANCE
WITH INTERNATIONAL LAW, A LAW WHICH IS RECOGNIZED BY ALL CIVILIZED
NATIONS.

THE ACCURATE AND PRECISE INFORMATION AVAILABLE TO OUR SIDE, AND
THE ABSENCE OF ANY OTHER AIRCRAFT IN THE VICINITY, CLEARLY ESTABLISH
THE FACT, BEYOND ANY DOUBT, THAT YOUR SIDE'S MISSILE WAS DELIBERATELY
DIRECTED AT THE UNC AIRCRAFT, AND THIS AIRCRAFT ONLY. YOUR SIDE HAD
ONE PURPOSE AND ONE PURPOSE ONLY: TO SHOOT DOWN OUR UNARMED AIR-
CRAFT.

THE FACT THAT YOUR SIDE FIRED IS A COMMENTARY ON YOUR SIDE'S
MALICIOUS DISREGARD FOR THE ARMISTICE AGREEMENT AND INDEED, DIS-
REGARD FOR PEACE ITSELF.

WERE IT NOT FOR THE FACT THAT YOUR SIDE'S MISSILE MISSED, OUR

UNARMED AIRCRAFT COULD HAVE BEEN DESTROYED AND THE CREW KILLED. HAD THIS OCCURRED, THIS PENINSULA WOULD HAVE BEEN BROUGHT TO THE BRINK OF A MAJOR CONFRONTATION, A CONFRONTATION DELIBERATELY PRECIPITATED -- AND EMPHASIZE DELIBERATELY PRECIPITATED -- BY YOUR SIDE'S CRIMINAL ACTS.

YOUR SIDE IS WELL AWARE THAT OUR SIDE ROUTINELY CONDUCTS THESE UNARMED RECONNAISSANCE FLIGHTS, FLIGHTS WHICH ARE BOTH LEGAL AND NON-AGGRESSIVE, FLIGHTS WHICH ARE FLOWN BY UNARMED AIRCRAFT, AND FLIGHTS WHICH ARE ALWAYS CAREFULLY CONTROLLED SO THAT THERE IS NO CHANCE THAT THEY WILL VIOLATE YOUR SIDE'S LEGAL AIRSPACE.

YOU KNOW FULL WELL THAT OUR SIDE'S RECONNAISSANCE AIRCRAFT DO NOT VIOLATE YOUR SIDE'S AIRSPACE. WE DO NOT ENTER YOUR SIDE'S AIRSPACE BECAUSE OUR SIDE RESPECTS OUR OBLIGATIONS UNDER THE AA AND THERE IS ABSOLUTELY NO NEED FOR OUR SIDE TO VIOLATE YOUR SIDE'S AIRSPACE IN ORDER TO CONDUCT THESE RECONNAISSANCE MISSIONS.

THE DEGREE OF YOUR SIDE'S CRIMINAL PREMEDITATION IN THIS MISSILE ATTACK IS INCREDIBLE. WITH FULL KNOWLEDGE OF BOTH THE PATH AND PRESENCE OF THESE ROUTINE RECONNAISSANCE FLIGHTS, YOUR SIDE, IN JUNE 1981, DELIBERATELY EMPLACED AN SA-2 MISSILE SITE AT THIS LOCATION WITH THE SPECIFIC INTENT TO ATTACK THESE UNARMED UNC RECONNAISSANCE FLIGHTS. THERE COULD BE NO OTHER REASON FOR THE CONSTRUCTION AND POSITIONING OF THAT SA-2 MISSILE SITE. THAT POSITION IS, IN FACT, THE ONLY LOCATION YOUR SIDE COULD HAVE EMPLACED AN SA-2 SITE WITH ANY HOPE OF HITTING OUR SIDE'S UNARMED AIRCRAFT, WHILE IN INTERNATIONAL AIRSPACE.

TODAY, I HAVE CLEARLY DOCUMENTED AN EXTREMELY SERIOUS BREACH OF THE PEACE BY YOUR SIDE. YOUR SIDE HAS DELIBERATELY EXECUTED A CAREFULLY PLANNED, & PREMEDITATED ATTACK ON AN UNARMED UNC AIRCRAFT OPERATING IN INTERNATIONAL AIRSPACE. THIS MINDLESS, MALICIOUS ACT COULD HAVE RESULTED IN GRAVE CONSEQUENCES.

I CANNOT OVEREMPHASIZE THE SERIOUSNESS WITH WHICH THE UNITED NATIONS COMMAND REGARDS THIS CRIMINAL ACT OF AGGRESSION BY YOUR SIDE. IN THIS INSTANCE WE HAVE CHOSEN THE OPTION OF RESTRAINT. WE HAVE CHOSEN TO SPEAK TO YOUR SIDE THROUGH THE MAC FORUM. HOWEVER, IF YOUR SIDE NOW CHOOSES TO AGAIN ATTACK ANY AIRCRAFT UNDER UNITED NATIONS CONTROL IN ANY AIR SPACE IN WHICH OUR AIRCRAFT ARE ENTITLED TO WHETHER BY INTERNATIONAL LAW OR BY AGREEMENT, THE UNITED NATIONS COMMAND WILL TAKE WHATEVER MEASURES ARE NECESSARY TO ENSURE THE SAFETY OF OUR AIRCRAFT AND CREWS. I REMIND YOU OF THE UNDERSTANDING REACHED DURING THE ARMISTICE NEGOTIATIONS. THAT UNDERSTANDING IS THAT EITHER SIDE IS ENTITLED TO TAKE WHATEVER MEASURES NECESSARY FOR SELF DEFENSE IN RESPONSE TO VIOLATIONS OF THE ARMISTICE PROVISIONS BY THE OTHER SIDE. YOUR SIDE IS AWARE OF THIS PROVISION; YOUR COMMANDER REFERRED TO IT IN HIS 21 AUGUST 1976 MESSAGE. THE UNC WILL REACT AGAINST THE SOURCE OF ANY FUTURE SUCH ATTACKS. IT WOULD BE A SERIOUS MISTAKE TO MISCALCULATE OUR RESOLVE IN THIS MATTER. WE HAVE CHOSEN THIS TABLE, THIS TIME, BUT WE WILL NOT ALLOW A REPETITION OF SUCH IRRESPONSIBLE, ILLEGAL, WARLIKE ACTS BY YOUR SIDE. I REPEAT, OUR SIDE WILL TAKE WHATEVER MEASURES NECESSARY TO ENSURE THE
