The President has received the attached letter from Mr. Morgan reporting the results of the 158th meeting. Because of your experience with the Board, I would appreciate your recommendation on the best way to handle the reply.

As you know, I personally acknowledged receipt of the minutes of the Board when the secretary forwarded them to Mr. Allen several weeks ago. This letter clearly requires a different level of response, either from the President himself or from Dick Allen.

My plan would be to prepare a reply for Allen's signature, acknowledging the letter, emphasizing the importance of the Board, and mentioning a couple of specific points. Clearly, the activities of the Board are nuts and bolts defense cooperation items which generally do not reach the NSC or White House level.

I have included at Tab B a proposed letter for Allen's signature. Please review it and change as necessary, or let me know if an entirely different format is more appropriate.
