On December 9 the Congress passed your package of waivers of U.S. law designed to facilitate the private financing of the Alaska Natural Gas Transportation System (ANGTS). When you submitted the waivers to Congress in October, you informed Prime Minister Trudeau of your action. (U)

US-Canadian relations have been troubled in recent months by differences over energy, investment and trade policy. However, two positive steps have been taken: the U.S. and Canada exchanged ratifications of the East Coast Boundary Treaty, and the Congress approved the pipeline waivers. (C)

The enclosed draft letter signals your satisfaction at these positives steps, and notes the need to work on ongoing issues. The State Department and Speechwriters have cleared the text of the letter.

That you sign the letter to Canadian Prime Minister Trudeau at Tab A.
