DEAR YAS:

-- I WANT TO OFFER MY WARM CONGRATULATION ON THE
RESULTS OF SUNDAY'S UPPER HOUSE ELECTIONS. I KNOW HOW
MUCH PERSONAL EFFORT YOU PUT INTO THE ELECTION CAMPAIGN,
AND I AM SURE YOU MUST BE GRATIFIED BY THE SUPPORT FOR
YOUR LEADERSHIP EXPRESSED BY THE JAPANESE PEOPLE. I LOOK
FORWARD TO CONTINUING TO WORK CLOSELY WITH YOU
PERSONALLY -- AS WE DID AT WILLIAMSBURG -- IN PURSUIT OF
WORLD PEACE, SECURITY AND PROSPERITY. RON
