TALKING POINTS FOR JAPAN

- President Reagan has sent me on this special mission to explain forced changes in his travel schedule.
- He sends his warmest greetings to the Prime Minister.
- It is with deep regret that because of the urgent issues before the Congress and the necessity for him to work closely with the Congress on these issues, he has decided that he must abbreviate his visit to Asia.
- He believes nevertheless that he should visit Japan, wishes and still intends to do so.
- We hope that the visit can be as long as previously discussed, and would like to continue planning along the lines of the previous schedule.
- Because of the Congressional schedule, we may ask to advance the visit by a few days; we should be able to discuss this with your Government shortly.
- I would like to stress and would appreciate your Government's understanding that the President's inability to visit Southeast Asia at this time indicates no lessening of the importance which the President and the United States attach to our relations with ASEAN and the member countries of ASEAN.
- He regrets that he has been forced to postpone his visit to Southeast Asia. We hope to reschedule a visit later to SEA.
