

HE SAID THAT FOREIGN MINISTER WHITEMAN'S RESIGNATION AND THE RESIGNATIONS OF OTHER PRO-BISHOP CABINET MINISTERS, TOGETHER WITH THE GROWING PUBLIC SUPPORT FOR BISHOP AS MANIFESTED IN PUBLIC DEMONSTRATIONS, MAY HAVE CHANGED THE CIRCUMSTANCES.
