2. IN RESPONSE TO MESSAGE RECEIVED BY EMBASSY BRIDGETOWN FROM REPRESENTATIVES OF THE REVOLUTIONARY MILITARY COUNCIL OF GRENADA, THE EMBASSY IS INSTRUCTED TO TRANSMIT A COMMERCIAL TELEX TO MAJOR CORNWALL, MAKING THE FOLLOWING POINTS:


