SHORTLY AFTER RECEIPT OF REFTEL, POLCOUNS RECEIVED A CALL FROM QUAI DIRECTOR FOR AMERICAN AFFAIRS DORIN REQUESTING HIM TO COME TO THE QUAL. DORIN OPENED THE MEETING BY NOTING THAT WITHIN THE HOUR THE FRENCH AMBASSADOR HAD RECEIVED A CALL FROM THE STATE DEPARTMENT INFORMING HIM THAT A MILITARY OPERATION WAS UNDERWAY IN GRENADA. HE ALSO NOTED THAT RADIO FREE GRENADA HAD ANNOUNCED THAT AN "UNIDENTIFIED" FORCE HAD ATTACKED THE ISLAND AND THAT THE POPULATION OF GRENADA WOULD FIGHT TO DEFEND ITSELF. DORIN QUOTED FROM AN AFP DISPATCH WHICH REPORTED THAT AN ASSAULT FORCE COMPOSED OF MARINES AS WELL AS FORCES FROM FOUR CARIBBEAN STATES (JAMAICA, BARBADOS, ANTIQUA AND ST. VINCENT) HAD ATTACKED GRENADA AND THAT THE MARINES HAD OCCUPIED THE PEARLS AIRPORT. HE ASKED FOR ADDITIONAL DETAILS.

3. POLCOUNS EXPLAINED THAT THE MILITARY ACTION ON GRENADA WAS A COLLECTIVE SECURITY ACTION WHICH WAS UNDERTAKEN IN RESPONSE TO A REQUEST FROM THE ORGANIZATION OF EASTERN CARIBBEAN STATES, AND THAT HE COULD CONFIRM THAT FORCES FROM JAMAICA AND BARBADOS AS WELL AS US TROOPS HAD RESPONDED TO THE OECS REQUEST. DORIN SEEMED UNFAMILIAR WITH THE OECS AND AT FIRST ASKED IF WE WERE REFERRING TO CARICOM. POLCOUNS POINTED OUT THAT IT WAS A DIFFERENT ORGANIZATION AND THAT IT WAS OUR UNDERSTANDING THAT THE OECS HAD ALSO APPEALED TO FRANCE TO PARTICIPATE IN THIS EFFORT.

DRAWING ON TALKING POINTS. POLCOUNS SAID THAT THERE WERE TWO PRIMARY REASONS FOR THE ACTION. WE WERE CERTAINLY CONCERNED ABOUT PROTECTING OUR CITIZENS AS WELL AS THOSE OF OTHER COUNTRIES. THE SECOND PURPOSE OF THE ACTION WAS, IN RESPONSE TO THE OECS REQUEST, TO REESTABLISH ORDER IN A CHAOTIC SITUATION WHICH HAD SHOCKED AND DISGUSTED GRENADA'S NEIGHBORS. 6. POLCOUNS TOLD DORIN THAT THE USG WOULD LIKE TO HAVE SUPPORT OF THE GOF FOR THIS OPERATION. DORIN FIRST QUERIED WHETHER WE WERE ASKING FOR POLITICAL/MORAL SUPPORT OR FOR MILITARY SUPPORT. HE THEN NOTED THAT THE GOF HAS NOT YET DECIDED WHAT ITS POSITION WILL BE ON THIS MATTER. THEY WERE STILL TRYING TO OBTAIN MORE INFORMATION BEFORE TAKING A POSITION. DORIN SAID HE HOPED TO DISCUSS IT WITH FOREIGN MINISTER CHEYSSON TODAY. 

CHARGE DREW UPON TALKING POINTS PARA 3 REFTEL TO NOTIFY FGN THAT US FORCES PARTICIPATING IN A CARIBBEAN NATIONAL COLLECTIVE SECURITY FORCE HAVE LANDED IN GRENADA. THE HOPES OF THE US THAT IT COULD COUNT ON THE UNDER-STANDING OF NIGERIA WERE EMPHASIZED. MESSAGE WAS CONVEYED TO AMBASSADOR GEORGE DOVE-EDWIN. DIRECTOR GENERAL FOR REGIONAL AFFAIRS, AND SECOND RANKING OFFICIAL IN MEA. 3. AMBASSADOR DOVE-EDWIN ACKNOWLEDGED THE REQUEST FOR "UNDERSTANDING" AND EXPRESSED APPRECIATION FOR INFORMA-TION. HE ASKED IF HE COULD RECEIVE ADDITIONAL INFORMA-TION AS SOON AS IT WAS AVAILABLE TO EMBASSY. HE SPECIFICALLY REQUESTED DETAILS ON THE COMPOSITION OF THE COLLECTIVE SECURITY FORCE: HOW MANY US. BARBADOS AND JAMAICAN PERSONNEL WERE INVOLVED. CHARGE UNDERTOOK TO PROVIDE INFORMATION THAT BECAME AVAILABLE INCLUDING TEXT OF PRESIDENT'S ADDRESS TO THE AMERICAN PEOPLE. 4. AMBASSADOR DOVE-EDWIN STATED THAT HE READILY APPRE-CIATED CONCERNS OF THE UNITED STATES AND OTHER COUNTRIES FOR THE SAFETY OF THEIR CITIZENS. HE OPINED THAT THE US HAD UNDERTAKING A SIGNIFICANT BURDEN. HE SAID THAT THE TASK OF "WORKING THE THE PEOPLE OF GRENADA TO RESTORE ORDER" WOULD NOT BE EASY AND COULD KEEP THE US INVOLVED ON THE ISLAND FOR SOME TIME.

5. AMBASSADOR DOVE-EDWIN NOTED THAT HE HAD BEFN FOLLOWING RECENT EVENTS ON THE ISLAND WITH CONSIDERABLE INTEREST AND THAT HE HAD A LONG PROFESSIONAL ASSOCIATION WITH GRENADA. IN 1974 HE WAS THE ESCORT OFFICER FOR PRIME

AT 0930 HOURS CUBAN RADIO ANNOUNCED THAT U.S. PARATROOPERS HAD LANDED AT NEW AIRPORT IN GRENADA NEAR CAMPS OF CUBAN CONSTRUCTION WORKERS. ANNOUNCEMENT STATED THAT CONSTRUCTION WORKERS HAVE INSTRUCTIONS TO DEFEND THEMSELVES IF THEY ARE ATTACKED. LOSSES HAVE RESULTED BUT INFORMATION ABOUT DEAD AND WOUNDED NOT YET AVAILABLE. FROM OTHER SOURCES WE BELIEVE MOBILIZATION ORDERS HAVE BEEN GIVEN TO CUBAN ARMED FORCES. IN VIEW THESE EVENTS HAVE IMPLEMENTED EMERGENCY ACTION PLAN AND BEGUN DESTRUCTION OF RECORDS. POSSIBLE THAT CUBAN WILL REPEAT MARCH ON USINT THAT THEY ORGANIZED DURING MARIEL. HOWEVER, I HAVE NO RPT
