(S) SUMMARY: IN RESPONSE TO A QUESTION, THATCHER STRESSED THAT NO BRITISH TROOPS ARE INVOLVED, THAT IN CONSULTATION WITH THE US MONDAY NIGHT SHE HAD RAISED HMG'S VERY CONSIDERABLE DOUBTS, BUT THAT THE US AND A NUMBER OF EASTERN CARIBBEAN STATES WHO ARE CLOSER TO THE PROBLEM DECIDED THAT THEY HAD TO ACT.
2. (S) AFTER HOWE READ A PREPARED STATEMENT (GIST IN PARA 7 BELOW), LABOR SPOKESMAN ASKED TOUGH QUESTIONS ABOUT CONSULTATIONS WITH THE US AND SOME COMMONWEALTH PARTNERS, AND ABOUT INVASION OF A COMMONWEALTH COUNTRY SUBJECT TO THE QUEEN. IMPLICATIONS FOR JOINT DECISION ON CRUISE MISSILES WERE RAISED TWICE. HOWE REBUTTED THAT US AND CARIBBEAN COUNTRIES, AFTER BEING MADE AWARE OF BRITISH DOUBTS, REACHED CONCLUSION THAT SITUATION REQUIRED ACTION. END SUMMARY.
3. (S) A CONSERVATIVE MP ASKED THATCHER WHETHER BRITISH TROOPS HAD TAKEN PART, WHETHER THERE HAD BEEN CONSULTATION WITH THE US, AND WHAT ROLE THE COMMONWEALTH NATIONS WERE TAKING.
4. (S) THATCHER SAID THERE WERE NO BRITISH TROOPS INVOLVED AND THAT REGARDING CONSULTATIONS HMG HAD RECEIVED A MESSAGE FROM USG SOME FOUR HOURS AFTER FOREIGN SECRETARY HOWE HAD MADE HIS REMARKS IN PARLIAMENT OCTOBER 24. SHE CHARACTERIZED THE US MESSAGE AS A STATEMENT SEEKING

BRITISH ADVICE. IN RESPONSE SHE SAID HMG HAD EXPRESSED VERY CONSIDERABLE DOUBTS AND ASKED THE USG "TO WEIGH CAREFULLY THESE POINTS." SHE CONCLUDED BY EXPRESSING UNDERSTANDING FOR THE FACT THAT WASHINGTON IN CONSULTATION WITH EASTERN CARIBBEAN STATES, WHO ARE MUCH CLOSER TO THE PROBLEM, REACHED A CONCLUSION THAT ACTION WAS REQUIRED.

6. (U) THATCHER ANSWERED THAT FOREIGN SECRETARY HOWE'S STATEMENT OF MONDAY HAD BEEN ACCURATE ABOUT THE SITUATION AND HAD NOT MENTIONED ANY AMERICAN UNDERTAKING NOT TO INTERVENE. THEREFORE THERE WAS NO QUESTION OF DECEPTION AND ON THE OTHER PARALLELS CONTAINED IN THE QUESTION, SHE STRESSED THAT THEY DID NOT EXIST.

7. (U) SUMMARY OF FOREIGN SECRETARY HOWE'S STATEMENT: ON MONDAY, OCTOBER 24, AFTER HIS STATEMENT TO THE PARLIAMENT, THE US INFORMED HMG OF A REQUEST BY THE ORGANIZATION OF EASTERN CARIBBEAN STATES FOR US ASSISTANCE IN A MILITARY INTERVENTION. HMG RAISED SOME SERIOUS QUESTIONS TO WHICH THE US REPLIED, STRESSING THAT THE US COMMUNITY IN GRENADA WAS FIVE TIMES LARGER THAN THE BRITISH POPULATION, AND THAT MANY WERE GROWING DESPERATE AND CONSIDERING ESCAPE PLANS. HOWE THEN LISTED THE EASTERN CARIBBEAN COUNTRIES WHO HAD TAKEN PART IN TODAY'S ACTION; HE CLARIFIED THAT NO BRITISH TROOPS WERE INVOLVED, AND THAT THE BRITISH DESTROYER HMS ANTRIM WAS STANDING CLEAR OF THE AREA. HOWE'S STATEMENT CLOSED BY NOTING THAT WHILE HMG WAS NOT SURE HOW THE SITUATION WOULD DEVELOP ON THE GROUND, HMG HOOPED IT WOULD LEAD TO CREATION OF DEMOCRATIC AND PEACEFUL POSSIBILITIES FOR GRENADA.

8. (U) LABOR FOREIGN AFFAIRS SPOKESMAN DENIS HEALEY SAID GRENADA WAS A SOVEREIGN MEMBER OF THE COMMONWEALTH AND SUBJECT TO THE QUEEN, AND THAT NOTHING COULD EXCUSE US AND OECS ACTION. HEALEY ASKED NUMBER OF SKILLFUL QUESTIONS ABOUT WHEN HMG HAD BEEN INFORMED OF OECS REQUESTS, AND WHETHER HMG HAD BEEN DECEIVED. HE ALSO ASKED IF US ACTION NUT BRITISH CITIZENS AT GREATER


