2. SUMMARY. MR. DEN HILL SPECIAL ASSISTANT TO THE PRESIDENT FOR OLYMPIC SECURITY, AND THE AMBASSADOR MET JANUARY 13 FOR ALMOST AN HOUR WITH YUGOSLAV INTERIOR MINISTER DOLANC TO DISCUSS THE FORTHCOMING SARAJEVO AND LOS ANGELES OLYMPIC GAMES AND THE POTENTIAL TERRORIST THREAT TO BOTH EVENTS. DOLANC PROMISED FULL COOPERATION WITH THE U.S. IN COUNTERING ANY TERRORIST ACTIVITIES. HE SAID THE YUGOSLAVS WOULD PASS ALONG ANY INFORMATION THEY HAD WHICH MIGHT RELATE TO TERRORISM AND THE L.A. GAMES. HE ALSO MADE A LOW-KEY PITCH FOR CONTINUED COOPERATION WITH THE USG IN THE COUNTER-TERRORISM FIELD. END SUMMARY.

3. DOLANC OPENED THE MEETING BY MAKING A FAIRLY LENGTHY STATEMENT ABOUT HIS CONCERN OVER TERRORIST THREATS TO THE OLYMPIC GAMES IN SARAJEVO AND LOS ANGELES. HE MADE HIS STANDARD PITCH TO THE EFFECT THAT FOR THE YUGOSLAVS "BLACK OR RED" TERRORISM WAS EQUALLY BAD. HE WELCOMED THE USG SECURITY TEAM'S VISIT TO YUGOSLAVIA IN THAT IT PROMISED CLOSE COOPERATION BOTH WITH REGARD TO SARAJEVO AND WITH LOS ANGELES. 4. DOLANC DISCOURSED ON THE INCREASE IN TERRORISM IN THE WORLD. HE SAID THERE WERE NEW GROUPS APPEARING ALMOST EVERY WEEK. THE YUGOSLAVS HAD DETECTED A PARTICULARLY CLOSE CONNECTION BETWEEN DRUG DEALING AND TERRORISM INASMUCH AS TERRORISTS NEEDED MONEY TO FUNCTION. DRUGS PROVIDED THE FINANCIAL BASE. HE NOTED ALSO THAT THE YUGOSLAV EXPERIENCE HAD BEEN THAT ALL TERRORIST GROUPS--ARAB, EUROPEAN OR ARMENIAN-- HAD CONNECTIONS WITH THREE OR FOUR DIFFERENT INTELLIGENCE SERVICES AROUND THE WORLD. HE SAID THAT PERSONALLY HE FELT THAT THE WORLD WAS FACING A NEW WAVE OF TERROR, PARTICULARLY IN EUROPE. SOME EUROPEAN STATES, E.G. FRANCE, SEEMED TO BELEIVE THAT THEY COULD MAKE DEALS WITH TERRORIST ORGANIZATIONS. THE TYPICAL APPORACH WAS FOR THE GOVERNMENT TO ASK THE TERRORIST ORGANIZATION NOT TO CARRY OUT ANY ACTIVITIES ON ITS TERRITORY IN EXCHANGE FOR TTHE GOVERNMENT'S PROMISE NOT TO PURSUE THE GOYP LEGALLY. HE POINTED OUT THAT THESE GROUPS WERE NOT PREDICTABLE, HOWEVER, AND ONE COULD NOT EXCLUDE THEIR ACTING IN THE COUNTRY WHERE THEY WERE BASED.

5. THIS LED DOLANC TO COMMENT ON YUGOSLAVIA'S POSITION. HE CONCEDED THAT YUGOSLAVIA HAD DIPLOMATIC RELATIONS WITH COUNTRIES THAT SUPPORT TERRORIST ORGANIZATIONS OF THEIR OWN. SOME OF THESE TERRORIST ORGANIZATIONS SEEMED TO BELEIVE THAT THEY WERE IN FREIENDLY TERRITORY WHEN THEY WERE IN YUGOSLAVIA. HE SAID THIS WAS NOT THE CASE. HE REFERRED TO THE YUGOSLAV ARREST OF A GROUP WHICH HAD WISHED TO BLOW UP THE U.S. AMBASSADOR'S "RESIDENCE" SOME MONTHS AGO. (COMMENT. WE BELEIVE HE WAS REFERRING TO THE U.S. EMBASSY AND NOT TO THE RESIDENCE, SINCE HE HAD PREVIOUSLY INFORMED US OF THE ARAB GROUP'S SURVEILLANCE OF THE EMBASSY AND OF THE YUGOSLAV ARREST OF THE GROUP.) 7. DOLANC ALSO TALKED ABOUT HIS EFFORTS OF MANY YEARS TO COOPERATE WITH THE FRG AUTHORITIES IN COUNTERING TERRORISM. HE SAID THESE EFFORTS HAD NOT REALLY WORKED OUT WELL. HE COMMENTED THAT THE GOY HAD JUST BROKEN A CAR STEALING RING CENTERED IN WEST GERMANY AND "LED BY YUGOSLAV TERRORISTS." THE YUGOSLAVS HAD LOCATED SOME 130 OF THE 200 CARS STOLEN AND HAD INFORMED THE GERMANS OF THE NAMES OF THE RING LEADERS AND OF THE METHOD OF OPERATION. HE COMPLAINED LOUDLY THAT THE GERMAN AUTHORITIES HAD SO FAR DONE NOTHING WITH THIS INFORMATION AND HE WAS NOW CONSIDERING LEAKING THE ENTIRE AFFAIR TO THE PRESS. 9. MR. HILL THANKED DOLANC FOR THIS EXPLANATION OF THE YUGOSLAV POSITION. HE NOTED THAT HE KNEW DOLANC HAD REGULAR TALKS WITH THE AMBASSADOR WHO REPORTED THEM TO HIGH LEVELS OF THE U.S. GOVERNMENT. THIS DIALOGUE WAS MUCH APPRECIATED BY THE U.S. SIDE. MR. HILL SAID THAT THE USG HAD THE SAME INTEREST AS THE GOY IN STRENGTHENING COOPERATION SO THAT NOT TERRORIST EVENTS OCCURRED EITHER IN SARAJEVO OR IN LOS ANGELES. COUNTERING TERRORISM GENERALLY, BUT PARTICULARLY AT THE GAMES, WAS A MATTER THAT HAD THE ATTENTION OF THE HIGHEST LEVELS OF THE U.S. GOVERNMENT. MR. HILL SAID THAT THE USG WOULD PROVIDE ANY INFORMATION PERTAINING TO ANY POTENTIAL TERRORIST THREATS IN SARAJEVO SUBJECT TO CONSTRAINTS OF THE U.S. CONSTITUTIONAL SYSTEM. THE USG ACCORDED THE HIGHEST PRIORITY TO COUNTERING TERRORISM, BOTH DURING THE GAMES AND AFTERWARDS. HE SAID THE USG LOOKED FORWARD TO MAINTAINING COOPERATION IN COUNTERING TERRORISM IN THE FUTURE. DOLANC WAS CLEARLY PLEASED BY THIS STATEMENT AND EXPRESSED HIS APPRECIATION FOR MR. HILL'S REMARKS.

COMMENT: DOLANC WAS ACCOMPANIED BY THREE OF HIS SENIOR OFFICIALS AT THE MEETING. HE WAS IN AN OPEN, EVEN AMIABLE, MOOD AND SPOKE WITH HIS USUAL DIRECTNESS. THE ATMOSPHERE OF THE MEETING WAS FRIENDLY AND COOPERATIVE THROUGHOUT, WITH BOTH DOLANC AND MR.
