1. (U) AS COMMUNICATED REF A, LT. GEN GUILLERMO QUINTANA LACACI, FORMER CAPITAN GENERAL OF SPAIN'S FIRST MILITARY DISTRICT, WAS GUNNED DOWN BY SUSPECTED ETA TERRORISTS JUST BEFORE 1300 TODAY (JAN 29) AS HE LEFT MADRID'S SACRED HEART CHURCH FOLLOWING SUNDAY MASS NEAR HIS HOME. HIS WIFE, MARIA ELENA RAMOS, WAS HIT IN THE LEG AND A RETIRED SPANISH ARMY COLONEL PASSING NEARBY ALSO WAS SLIGHTLY INJURED.

ACCORDING TO PRELIMINARY REPORTS, TWO TERRORISTS FIRED AT THE GENERAL FROM A MOVING VEHICLE, HITTING HIM AT LEAST THREE TIMES IN THE HEAD AND UPPER BODY; HE APPARENTLY DIED INSTANTLY. ACCOMPLICES REORTEDLY ASSISTED THE ASSAILANTS IN THEIR FLIGHT FROM THE SCENE. POLICE HAVE LOCATED THE PRINCIPAL VEHICLE USED IN THE ATTACK AND HAVE PICKED UP AT

THE SCENE OF THE KILLING 9 MM PARABELLUM CARTRIDGES -AMMUNITION USUALLY IDENTIFIED WITH ETA OPERATIONS. SPEAKING FROM THE POPULAR ALLIANCE CONGRESS NOW UNDER WAY IN

BARCELONA, OPPOSITION LEADER MANUEL FRAGA TOLD THE MEDIA THIS AFTERNOON THAT PRIME MINISTER FELIPE GONZALEZ BELIEVES

MESSAGE / ANNOTATION:

THAT CHANCES ARE OVER 90 PERCENT THAT ETA-M (MILITARY) WAS RESPONSIBLE. GONZALEZ CALLED FRAGA TO REPORT THE INCIDENT AND REPORTEDLY WENT PERSONALLY TO PAY HIS RESPECTS AT THE CLINIC WHERE QUINTANA'S BODY WAS TRANSFERRED. IN A STATE-MENT LATE THIS AFTERNOON, MADRID CIVIL GOVERNOR JUAN MARIA RODRIGUEZ COLORADO CONFIRMED THAT ETA-M IS THE PRIME SUSPECT.

2. (U) CONDEMNATIONS OF THE KILLING HAVE COME SWIFTLY FROM TOP GOVERNMENT LEADERS, VIRTUALLY ALL NATIONAL POLITICAL PARTIES AND UNIONS, SEVERAL MILITARY LEADERS, AND THE BASQUE GOVERNMENT. A SPOKESMAN FOR THE PNV (BASQUE NATIONAL PARTY), WHICH HAS SET A MEETING OF ITS EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE FOR TOMORROW TO DISCUSS THE ASSASSINATION, SAID THAT IT WAS CHARACTERISTIC OF ETA TO "HURL BODIES INTO THE BALLOT BOX", REFERRING TO THE FEB 26 BASQUE REGIONAL ELECTIONS. EE (EUSKADIKO EZKERRA - BASQUE LEFT) LEADER ROBERTO LERTXUNDI SAID TODAY THAT SUCH A DESPERATE ACT IN THE MIDST OF THE CAMPAIGN WOULD ONLY FURTHER WEAKEN EXTREME SEPARATIST GROUPS AMONG BASQUE VOTERS AND WAS A CLEAR SIGN THAT "ETA HAS LOST THE WAR".

(C) COMMENT: THE 67-YEAR-OLD QUINTANA WAS A MUCH RESPECTED FIGURE IN SPAIN'S TRANSITION TO DEMOCRACY. WHILE IN COMMAND IN MADRID, HE OPENLY DEFENDED THE NATION'S 1978 DEMOCRATIC CONSTITUTION AND IS REMEMBERED FOR HIS DECISIVE EFFORTS IN TURNING BACK THE ABORTIVE MILITARY COUP OF FEBRUARY 1981. AT THE SAME TIME, THE GENERAL WAS A POLITICAL CONSERVATIVE WHO FAVORED A STRONGER GOVERNMENT POLICY AGAINST WHAT HE BELIEVED WAS SOVIET-BACKED BASQUE TERRORISM. A GOOD FRIEND OF THE US EMBASSY. HE TOLD EMBOFF A FEW MONTHS AGO THAT HE KNEW FIRSTHAND THE SUFFERING ENDURED BY THE FAMILIES OF PAST ETA VICTIMS AND THAT HE WOULD NOT BE SATISFIED UNTIL ALL THE SENSELESS KILLING HAD STOPPED. IRONICALLY, HE HAS FALLEN VICTIM DURING A MAJOR ANTI-GOVERNMENT OFFENSIVE AGAINST ETA (REF B). QUINTANA PASSED TO NON-COMMAND STATUS (SITUATION B) IN APRIL 1982. AT WHICH TIME HE STEPPED DOWN FROM HIS COMMAND POSITION IN MADRID. THE MAJOR ELEMENT OF SURPRISE IN THE ATTACK TODAY WAS THAT ETA. SEEMING TO APPEAR MORE COWARDLY THAN CLEVER IN THE PUBLIC EYE, CHOSE A RELATIVELY EASY TARGET IN QUINTANA. A MAN WHO HAS LONG SINCE PASSED FROM THE TRAPPINGS (AND HEAVY SECURITY PROTECTION) OF POWER. WE SUSPECT THAT THE INCIDENT WILL PUT THE GOVERNMENT ON THE ALERT TO THE POSSIBILITY OF A MORE SENSATIONAL EFFORT BY ETA IN THE NEAR FUTURE. ENDERS

2. SHE NOTIFIED THE MSG ON DUTY WHO SOUNDED THE MARINE RECALL AND CONTACTED THE ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICER WHO INITIATED EVACUATION PROCEDURES. THE ENTIRE EMBASSY WAS CLEARED AND THE MSGS HAD BEGUN SEARCH PROCEDURES BY 0900. BY 1000 THE EMBASSY AND THE STAFF APARTMENT BUILDING ADJACENT HAD BEEN SEARCHED WITH NO RESULTS. THE CHARGE DECIDED TO RESUME NORMAL BUSINESS AT 1015. AT 1200 ALL IS STILL QUIET.
