THE MOST RECENT PROTEST ACTIVITIES AT SEAL BEACH INCLUDED A DEMONSTRATION ON 05 DEC 83 AGAINST THE DEPLOYMENT OF U.S. MISSILES IN EUROPE: THIRTEEN PERSONS WERE ARRESTED FOR TRESSPASSING WHEN THEY OBSTRUCTED TRAFFIC BY LAYING DOWN IN FRONT OF THE MAIN GATE. A CANDLELIGHT VIGIL WAS ALSO HELD ON 9 AUG 82 IN MEMORY OF THE WORLD WAR II ATTACKS ON HIROSHIMA AND NAGASAKI. AS A RESULT OF THIS, THE JAPANESE POLICE HAVE INCREASED SECURITY PATROLS OUTSIDE THE PERIMETER FENCE AT NRRF KAMI SEYA. (NAVCOMMSTA YOKOSUKA JA 170640Z JUL 84) ATAC COMMENT: (C/NF) THE TARGETS SELECTED BY THE ARSONISTS HAVE MAINLY BEEN JAPANESE DEFENSE FORCE RELATED, U.S. MILITARY INSTALLATIONS, AND FACILITIES RELATED TO THE NEW TOKYO INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT. JAPANESE POLICE REPORTEDLY BELIEVE THE "BATTLE FLAG FACTION" (SENKI-HA) WAS RESPONSIBLE FOR THE FIREBOMBING AT KAMI SEYA. THE SENKI-HA HAS CARRIED OUT MULTIPLE FIREBOMBINGS OF THIS TYPE IN THE PAST. AS ASSESSED IN ATACSUM 101-84, NUISANCE ATTACKS BY LEFTIST RADICALS WILL PROBABLY CONTINUE.
