(U) JAPAN: AT APROXIMATELY 1155Z, ON 16 JULY, A SMALL INCENDIARY DEVICE PLACED NEXT TO AN EMERGENCY ELECTRICAL GENERATOR PAGE 03 RULYSGG2480 ~~S E C R E T~~ NOFORN NOCONTRACT WNINTEL ABOARD NAVY RADIO RECEIVING FACILITY KAMI SEYA IGNITED CAUSING DAMAGE TO THE GENERATOR. DAMAGE WAS LIMITED TO THE FRONT OF THE GENERATOR INCLUDING THE ELECTRICAL CONTROL BOX. THERE WAS NO IMPACT ON OPERATIONAL READINESS, BUT THE GENERATOR WILL BE INOPERABLE FOR AT LEAST ONE DAY. THE INTRUDERS APPARENTLY GAINED ENTRY TO THE FACILITY BY CUTTING A 4.5 FT BY 2.5 FT HOLE IN THE PERIMETER FENCE APPROXIMATLEY 30 YARDS FROM THE GENERATOR. LOCAL AUTHORITIES HAVE THE REMAINS OF THE DEVICE IN CUSTODY AND ARE ANALYSING THE DEBRIS WHICH INDICATE A TIMED DEVICE WAS USED. (NAVCOMMSTA YOKOSUKA JA 161446Z JUL 84)

ATAC COMMENT: (C/NF) ALTHOUGH NO INDIVIDUAL/GROUP HAS CLAIMED CREDIT FOR THE ATTACK AT THIS TIME, THIS TYPE OF ACTIVITY FITS MODUS OPERANDI OF THE NUCLEUS FACTION (CHUKAKU-HA), WHICH HAS TAKEN CREDIT FOR NUMEROUS ATTACKS AGAINST U.S. AND JAPANESE GOVERNMENT FACILITIES IN THE PAST. RECENT ARTICLES IN LEFTIST RADICAL ORGANIZATIONAL PUBLICATIONS HAVE BEEN ADVOCATING ANTI-U.S./ANTI-BASE ACTIVITIES SINCE EARLY JUN 84. WITHIN THE LAST YEAR AND A HALF, CHUKAKU-HA HAS BEEN INVOLVED IN VARIOUS VIOLENT INCIDENTS AGAINST U.S. BASES WHICH INCLUDE: (1) MAR 83, AN INCENDIARY DEVICE WAS DISCOVERED AT THE U.S. NAVY'S HARIO-SHIMA ORDNANCE FACILITY AT PAGE 04 RULYSGG2480 ~~S E C R E T~~ NOFORN NOCONTRACT WNINTEL SASEBO, KYUSHU; IT DID NOT IGNITE. (2) A NOV 83, ATTACK AGAINST THE USAF MAINTAINED SOFU TROPOSPHERIC SCATTER SITE IN YAMAGUCHI PREFECTURE. A DIFRACTION NET TOWER WAS CUT DOWN BUT THERE WERE NO INJURIES INVOLVED. BASED ON PREVIOUS TARGETING OF U.S. FACILITIES, THE NUISANCE ATTACKS AGAINST U.S. BASES BY LEFTIST RADICALS IN JAPAN WILL PROBABLY CONTINUE.

A. (S) GREECE: DURING A DEMONSTRATION ON 12 JUL, 150-200 STRIKINGGREEK EMPLOYEES AT HELLENIKON AIR BASE ATTEMPTED TO SEAL OFF THE BASE AND PREVENT ANY U.S. PERSONNEL FROM ENTERING OR LEAVING. GREEK POLICE ARRIVED AFTER TWO HOURS AND POSITIONED THEMSELVES BETWEEN THE STRIKERS AND THE GATE, ALLOWING U.S. MILITARY PERSONNEL FREE ACCESS. THE CHIEF OF THE ATHENS SUBURBS POLICE STATED THAT THE GREEK GOVERNMENT INTENDS TO PROVIDE ADEQUATE PROTECTION TO U.S. MILITARY PERSONNEL WHENEVER THEY ARE THREATENED WITH PHYSICAL HARM BY THE STRIKERS. EVEN THOUGH THERE WAS NO PHYSICAL CONTACT BETWEEN POLICE AND STRIKERS ON 12 JUL, THE GREEK COMMUNIST PARTY (KKE) NEWSPAPER REPORTED THAT POLICE HAD CLUBBED STRIKERS. ON 14 JUL THE SEDIPA U.S. BASE EMPLOYEES UNION VOTED TO EXTEND THE STRIKE ANOTHER TEN DAYS, TO JUL 26, PROBABLY AS A RESULT OF MINIMAL PROGRESS BEING MADE TOWARD SETTLING STRIKE ISSUES. (CINCUSNAVEUR 151910Z JUL 84)

ATAC COMMENT: (S) THE ACTION OF THE GREEK POLICE APPEARS TO AFFIRM THE PROMISES MADE EARLIER BY THE GREEK PRIME MINISTER (NAVATACSUM 100-84) THAT STRONGER POLICE MEASURES WOULD BE TAKEN AGAINST THE STRIKERS. HOWEVER, THE QUALIFICATION PROVIDED BY THE CHIEF OF ATHENS SUBURBS POLICE, "THAT ADEQUATE PROTECTION WOULD BE PROVIDED TO U.S. FORCES PERSONNEL WHENEVER THEY ARE THREATENED WITH 'PHYSICAL HARM,'" INDICATES THAT GREEK POLICE ACTIVITY WILL STILL BE RELATIVELY CONSTRAINED. THE GREEK PRIME MINISTER UNDOUBTEDLY WISHES TO AVOID AN OPEN CONFLICT WITH THE STRIKERS IN WHICH HIS GOVERNMENT WOULD SEEM TO BE SIDING WITH THE U.S.. ADDITIONALLY, THE INFLAMMATORY REPORTING IN THE KKE NEWSPAPER RAISES THE SPECTRE OF KKE INVOLVMENT IN THE STRIKE, WHICH WOULD GREATLY INCREASE THE NUMBER OF STRIKERS OUTSIDE THE GATES AND RAISE THE LEVEL OF TENSIONS.

THE ORGANIZATION PLANNING THE VIGIL HAS CONDUCTED PREVIOUS DEMONSTRATIONS AT THE SEAL BEACH COMPLEX IN WHICH ARRESTS WERE MADE FOR OBSTRUCTING VEHICULAR/PEDESTRIAN TRAFFIC. THE ORGANIZATION IS NOT KNOWN FOR VIOLENCE AND HAS THUS FAR LIMITED ITS ACTIVITIES TO NON-VIOLENT CIVIL DISOBEDIENCE. (NAVINSERVRA LONG BEACH CA 131625Z JUL 84)

ATAC COMMENT (C): THE WEEK OF NINE AUGUST HAS BEEN A HISTORICAL TIME OF PROTEST FOR ANTI-NUCLEAR GROUPS IN THE UNITED STATES. THE MOST RECENT PROTEST ACTIVITIES AT SEAL BEACH INCLUDED A DEMONSTRATION ON 05 DEC 83 AGAINST THE DEPLOYMENT OF U.S. MISSILES IN EUROPE; THIRTEEN PERSONS WERE ARRESTED FOR TRESSPASSING WHEN THEY OBSTRUCTED TRAFFIC BY LAYING DOWN IN FRONT OF THE MAIN GATE. A CANDLELIGHT VIGIL WAS ALSO HELD ON 9 AUG 82 IN MEMORY OF THE WORLD WAR II ATTACKS ON HIROSHIMA AND NAGASAKI. THE AUG 82 DEMONSTRATION WAS BASICALLY PEACEFUL; THE ONLY REPORTED CIVIL DISOBEDIENCE AGAIN TOOK THE FORM OF VEHICULAR OBSTRUCTION. INDICATIONS ARE THAT SIMILAR ACTIVITY IS PLANNED THIS YEAR. AS A RESULT OF THIS, THE JAPANESE POLICE HAVE INCREASED SECURITY PATROLS OUTSIDE THE PERIMETER FENCE AT NRRF KAMI SEYA. (NAVCOMMSTA YOKOSUKA JA 170640Z JUL 84)

ATAC COMMENT: (C/NF) THE TARGETS SELECTED BY THE ARSONISTS HAVE MAINLY BEEN JAPANESE DEFENSE FORCE RELATED, U.S. MILITARY INSTALLATIONS, AND FACILITIES RELATED TO THE NEW TOKYO INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT. JAPANESE POLICE REPORTEDLY BELIEVE THE "BATTLE FLAG FACTION" (SENKI-HA) WAS RESPONSIBLE FOR THE FIREBOMBING AT KAMI SEYA. THE SENKI-HA HAS CARRIED OUT MULTIPLE FIREBOMBINGS OF THIS TYPE IN THE PAST. AS ASSESSED IN ATACSUM 101-84, NUISANCE ATTACKS BY LEFTIST RADICALS WILL PROBABLY CONTINUE.
