LOCAL TIME TODAY MONDAY, AUGUST 13, WAREHOUSE CREW MOVING PERSONAL EFFECTS FROM PRIVATE RESIDENCE (FORMERLY BELONGING TO GSO PEPPER) NOTICED SUSPICIOUS DEVICE LOCATED ON OUTSIDE OF PERIMETER WALL. 1. AN ARAB MALE FIRST REPORTED TO BE A SOUTH YEMENI DIPLOMAT BUT WHO MAY BE A PALESTINIAN BEARING FALSE DOCUMENTS WAS SERIOUSLY WOUNDED BY TWO TERRORISTS IN MADRID AUGUST 17. WHILE FACTS STILL REMAIN UNCLEAR, THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION IS BEING REPORTED BY SPANISH POLICE OFFICIALS AND THE PRESS: THE VICTIM WAS SHOT AROUND 12:10 PM AS HE TURNED FROM A SIDE STREET ONTO ONE OF MADRID'S BUSIEST AVENUES. TWO ARAB-LOOKING MALES ON A MOTORCYCLE INTERCEPTED THE CAR AS IT MADE THE TURN, FIRED SHOTS AND SPED AWAY. WITNESSES BELIEVE THAT A CAR BEHIND THAT OF THE VICTIM MAY ALSO HAVE BEEN INVOLVED IN THE ATTEMPT, AS IT ALSO SPED AWAY AFTER THE SHOOTING. THE VICTIM, ORIGINALLY IDENTIFIED AS AWADH AHMAD SALAM, A FORTY-FOUR YEAR OLD SOUTH YEMENI DIPLOMAT STATIONED IN PARIS, IS NOW THOUGHT, ACCORDING TO PRESS REPORTS, TO BE A PALESTINIAN BEARING A FAKE OR ALTERED PASSPORT. TWO OTHER PERSONS IN THE VICTIM'S CAR ORIGINALLY IDENTIFIED AS HIS

BROTHER AND THE DRIVER WERE UNINJURED, BUT ARE BEING HELD BY THE POLICE.

2. NO ONE HAS YET CLAIMED RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE ATTACK AND NO MOTIVE HAS BEEN PROFFERED. SY IS MAINTAINING CONTACT WITH THE SPANISH POLICE, BUT THE INCIDENT DOES NOT APPEAR TO BE DIRECTED AT U.S. INTERESTS.

3. THIS INCIDENT COMPRISES THE SIXTH ATTEMPT ON THE LIFE OF AN ARAB IN SPAIN WITHIN THE PAST SIX YEARS. ON AUGUST 5, A KUWAITI NEWSPAPER PUBLISHER, KHALID AL MARZZOK, ESCAPED UNHARMED WHEN TERRORISTS SHOT AT HIS CAR, KILLING HIS DRIVER. ON DECEMBER 29, 1983, A JORDANIAN DIPLOMAT, WALID JAMAL BALKIZ, WAS SHOT AND KILLED AS HE DROVE OUT OF HIS EMBASSY BY A MEMBER OF THE "ARAB REVOLUTIONARY BRIGADES". A KUWAITI DIPLOMAT, NAJJEEB SAYED HASSHEM AL RAFAY, WAS KILLED SEPTEMBER 16, 1982 BY AN ABU NIDAL GUNMAN, WHILE A SYRIAN DIPLOMAT, HASSAN DAYOUB, ESCAPED UNHARMED FROM UNIDENTIFIED ASSASSINS ON APRIL 27, 1982. ON MARCH 1, 1982, A PALESTINIAN RESIDENT IN SPAIN FOR 10 YEARS, NABIL ARANKJ WADI, WAS MURDERED BY UNKNOWN ASSAILANTS. A. (S/NF) COLOMBIA: THE NATIONAL LIBERATION ARMY (ELN) IS THE ONLY MAJOR GUERRILLA ORGANIZATION THAT HAS NOT SIGNED A TRUCE WITH THE GOVERNMENT, AND AS SUCH IS NOW THE COLOMBIAN ARMY'S TOP COUNTERINSURGENCY PRIORITY. THE ARMY WILL MOUNT ITS ANTI-ELN OPERATIONS IN THE BORDER AREAS NEAREST VENEZUELA AND PANAMA, WHICH HAVE TRADITIONALLY BEEN THE HAVEN OF ELN ACTIVITY. BOTH THE COLOMBIANS AND VENEZUELAN ARE COOPERATING INFORMALLY IN CRACKING-DOWN ON DISSIDENT FACTIONS THAT OPERATE ALONG THEIR COMMON BORDER. SINCE AUG 84, MEETINGS BETWEEN COLOMBIAN AND VENEZUELAN ARMY OFFICALS HAVE TAKEN PLACE AT THE BRIGADIER GENERAL LEVEL TO DISCUSS BORDER INCIDENTS, TERRORIST INCIDENTS AND RECOMMENDATIONS ON FUTURE ACTIONS TO TAKE. ELN'S HAVEN NEAR THE PANAMANIAN BORDER IS MORE SECURE AND THE GOVERNMENT'S EFFORTS TO PENETRATE THAT AREA WILL ENCOUNTER GREATER DIFFICULTY AS DISTRUST BETWEEN THE COLOMBIAN AND PANAMANIAN GOVERNMENTS EXIST. A HEAVY CONCENTRATION OF DRUG TRAFFICKING AND A PROFITABLE TRADE IN ARMS FOR PANAMANIAN

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WILL MAKE IT MORE DIFFICULT FOR COLOMBIANS CONTAIN THE ELN IN THIS AREA OF THE COUNTRY AND IT IS ASSUMED THAT ELN MEMBERS WILL CONTINUE TO USE PANAMA AS A REFUGE IF COLOMBIAN AUTHORITIES ARE ABLE TO GAIN CONTROL OVER THE REGION. WITH DISSIDENT GROUPS HAS GIVEN THE GOVERNMENT THE ABILITY TO GO AFTER THE ONLY MAJOR GROUP THAT IS STILL CONDUCTING OPERATIONS AGAINST IT. THE ELN HAS BEEN ACTIVE AGAINST BOTH COLOMBIAN AND U.S. INTEREST IN THE COUNTRY. ELN TARGETING OF U.S. OFFICIALS AND BUSINESS PEOPLE (REPORTED IN ATACSUM 100-84) AND TARGETING OF THE U.S. EMBASSY AND THE U.S. AMBASSADOR (REPORTED IN ATACSUM 086-84) HAS DEMONSTRATED THEIR ABILITY TO UNDERMINE THE CONTROL OF COLOMBIAN SECURITY AUTHORITIES TO CONTAIN THE GROUP. WHILE THE COLOMBIAN ARMY IS ABLE TO REDIRECT ITS RESOURCES AGAINST THE ELN, THE COLOMBIAN GOVERNMENT MOST LIKELY WILL HAVE TO ENGAGE IN A POLITICAL BATTLE WITH THE GUERRILLA GROUPS THAT HAVE SIGNED A TRUCE WITH THEM.
