7. DUARTE'S PUBLIC POSTURE. IN AN INTERVIEW BROAD-
CAST ON RCTV CHANNEL 2, DUARTE EXPLAINED THE WAR IN
EL SALVADOR AS A POLITICAL ONE, ONE WHICH HAS TO BE
WON POLITICALLY THROUGH THE SOLIDARITY OF THE DEMO-

MESSAGE / ANNOTATION:

VENEZUELA AND COLOMBIA IS NECESSARY TO HAVE THE MORAL AUTHORITY TO PREVENT THE IMPOSITION OF DECISIONS ON THE PEOPLE BY OUTSIDE FORCES. "MY COUNTRY IS BURIED BENEATH A MOUNTAIN OF HATRED OF INEQUITY, OF PAIN AND ONE HAS TO GET IT OUT OF THERE. WE ARE GOING TO MOVE THAT MOUNTAIN AND FOR THAT I NEED THE FAITH OF THOSE WHO BELIEVE IN DEMOCRACY." IN ANOTHER INTERVIEW DUARTE SAID THAT EL SALVADOR IS A VICTIM OF "SUBVERSION AND TERRORISM UNDER THE PATRONAGE OF THE SOVIET UNION," AND ALSO NOTED THAT THE COUNTRY IS A VICTIM OF ABUSES BY THE EXTREME RIGHT. "WE ARE BATTLING THE DEATH SQUADS AND ALL THE PROBLEMS OF INJUSTICE AND ARROGANCE THAT HARM US," HE SAID.

8. THE VENEZUELAN REACTION. MANY OF OUR VENEZUELAN INTERLOCUTORS CHARACTERIZE DUARTE'S VISIT AS HIGHLY SUCCESSFUL, IN TERMS OF DUARTE'S ABILITY TO COMMUNICATE WITH VENEZUELAN IN AND OUT OF GOVERNMENT AND IN OVERCOMING WHATEVER NEGATIVE VIEWS MAY HAVE EXISTED. THE REACTION HERE IS DUARTE OBTAINED NOT ONLY POLITICAL AND MORAL SUPPORT, BUT ALSO ACHIEVED A CLOSE MEETING OF MINDS WITH LUSINCHI. THE INCREASING CONVERGENCE OF VIEWS BETWEEN VENEZUELA'S SOCIAL CHRISTIAN AND SOCIAL DEMOCRATIC AD LEADERS AND THE HIGH PROFILE SUPPORT OF A MAJOR SI MEMBER LIKE AD, IT IS BELIEVED, WILL HAVE A WIDE IMPACT WITH KEY COUNTRIES SUCH AS ARGENTINA, MEXICO AND SPAIN.
