2. CHARGE MET WITH QUAI SECGEN GUTMANN EVENING OF JANUARY 18 TO CARRY OUT REFTEL INSTRUCTION. DRAWING FULLY ON REFTEL TALKING POINTS, CHARGE SAID HE RECOGNIZED THAT FRENCH RELATIONS WITH IRAN WERE ALMOST AS BAD AS OURS, BUT THAT OUR EFFORT WAS DESIGNED TO SHOW THE IRANIANS THAT A BROAD SPECTRUM OF COUNTRIES WERE AWARE OF AND INDIGNANT ABOUT IRANIAN USE OF TERRORISM. 4. WITH REGARD TO POSSIBLE ACTIONS, GUTMANN SAID THE KEY WAS TO GET INTO THE RIGHT CHANNEL AND TO GET TO THE RIGHT IRANIAN OFFICIALS.
