THE IDF ALSO ANNOUNCED TOUGHER REGULATIONS RESTRICTING THE MOVEMENT OF CIVILIANS IN AREAS IT CONTROLS, AND STIPULATED THAT ONLY VEHICLES AUTHORIZED BY THE IDF WILL BE ALLOWED SOUTH OF THE LITANI RIVER BRIDGES, WHICH MARK THE CURRENT ISRAELI FRONT LINES IN LEBANON.
