MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD

SUBJECT: Attempted Assassination of President Ronald Reagan

On Monday, March 30, about 2:30, my Naval aide, Captain Bovey, appeared at the door of my office to advise me there was a radio report that there had been a shooting outside the hotel where President Reagan had been speaking at noon. I glanced over to the President's schedule on my desk and noted that he was scheduled to be through with his talk and depart the hotel at 2:35 p.m. I asked if the President had been near the shooting, and Bovey said the radio reports did not indicate so.

I continued work on the briefing papers for my next meeting, which was to be a talk with Admiral Inman who was introducing his successor at the National Security Agency, General Faurer.

As they came in, Captain Bovey again appeared and said that the radio had now reported that the shooting had taken place in the presence of the President but that it appeared the President had not been hit and was in his car apparently going to the hospital to see how some of the people who had been hit and who had been taken there, were faring. I said this sounds absolutely typical of the President, and then turned my own radio on. The radio was now reporting that the President was on his way to the hospital but had not been hit. Admiral Inman and General Faurer came in, but almost immediately my secretary told me that the White House had called and I was wanted at the Situation Room immediately.

Admiral Inman excused himself and we called for my driver. They did not locate him immediately so Admiral Inman offered to take me to the White House. I drove with him to the Situation Room, arriving I believe a few minutes before 3:00.

On the car radio we heard more and more detailed accounts on the incident. They were now reporting that the President had indeed been hit, and was under treatment at the hospital; that Jim Brady had been seriously hurt and that two others, a Secret Service man and a policeman had also been shot, but that the extent of their injuries was not known. There were accounts too, that the suspect was in custody.

In the Situation Room when I arrived were Dick Allen, Al Haig, Don Regan, Bill Casey, and several other people I did not know. Others kept moving in and out. I believe it was shortly thereafter that Bill French Smith came. Also, there seemed to be various aides of these men present. There was a small tape recorder on the table, and occasionally Dick Allen changed tapes. The television set mounted near the ceiling of the room was giving repeated accounts of the incident and showing films of the actual shooting.

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MAIN ACCOUNT

Very shortly after arriving at the Situation Room, I inquired about Ed Meese and Mike Deaver. I was told that Mike had been with the President but was apparently not hurt, and that Ed Meese was at the hospital.

The television films showed Mike Deaver either ducking or falling, and I was concerned he had been shot. Various calls were coming in and were being answered from time to time. Al Haig had one of the secure phones in front of him near one end of the table and another phone in the room was busy. I stepped out to call Ed Meese at the hospital, or Ed Meese called me, I cannot recall which, at approximately 3:15, or perhaps closer to 3:30 o'clock. My conversation with Ed Meese was somewhat reassuring in that he told me that he did not think the President was seriously hurt but that they were going to have exploratory surgery. He then said to me, "Under these circumstances, it is my understanding the National Command Authority devolves on you." I said that I believed the chain started with the Vice President. Ed Meese said the Vice President was on a plane in Texas which was being diverted back to Washington and that it would take him approximately two hours to get here. I asked about the communication to the plane, and which plane it was, and Ed said that he did not know but he did not think there was secure communication. He mentioned again the chain of leadership under the National Command Authority and I confirmed I was the next in line after the Vice President. We talked a bit more about the condition of the President, and I returned to the Situation Room to see if one of the secure phones was free. It was not, but there was considerable discussion going on about the television appearance of Larry Speakes who was in the White House Press Room and whose statement was coming over the television set at that time. Speakes was responding to questions from the press about the location of the Vice President, the condition of the President, and about whether there had been any transfer of the authority from the President. He answered no or occasionally "I don't know" to these questions. Al Haig was visibly restless during this performance and said Speakes should not be answering questions. I agreed, saying that in my opinion a short statement should be handed out and no questions taken, at least until we knew a great deal more. Haig seemed to agree with that.

The phones were still busy, so I stepped outside the room to another security telephone and called General Jones. He said that he had heard the news about the President. I passed on Ed Meese's statements about the President having exploratory surgery, but that he appeared to be in good condition and not badly hurt.

I then asked about the alert condition of our forces.

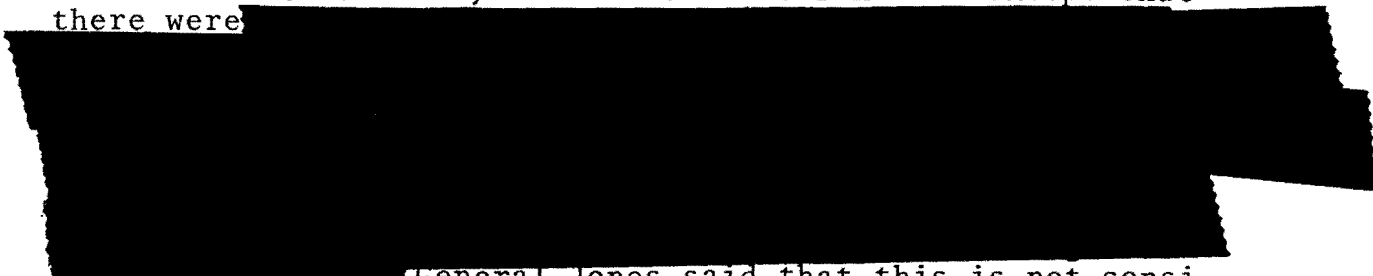

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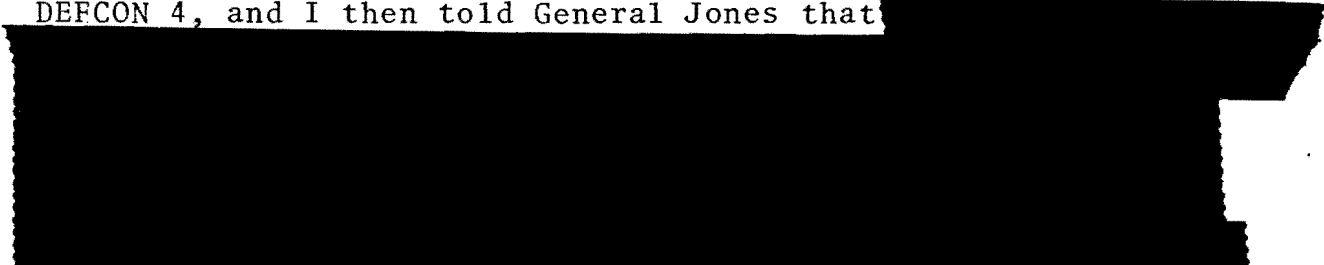
I asked General Jones if he had any information about any other activities that might indicate attempts by the Soviets or anyone else to take advantage of the news of the attempt on the President's life, or whether he had any information from any source to indicate whether or not this was merely an isolated attempt on the President as opposed to being linked to some sort of coordinated activity. General Jones said he had no such information. I asked about the position of the Soviet forces and he said they were more or less normal except that there were

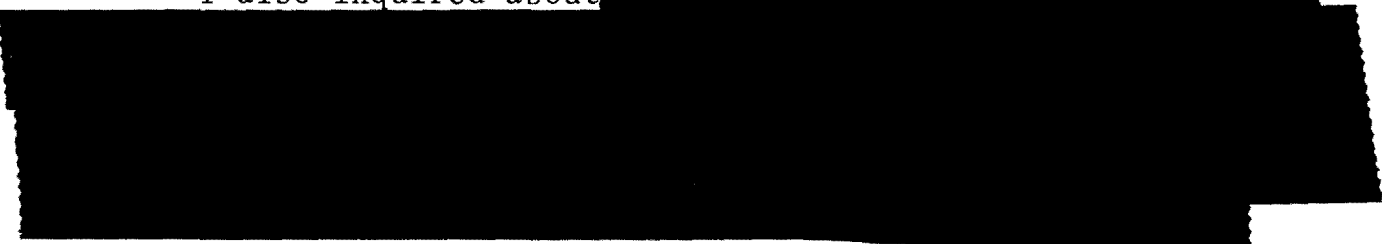
General Jones said that this is not considered extremely unusual and that it did occur from time to time, but that it was outside the normal pattern.

We discussed the general differences between DEFCON 5 and DEFCON 4, and I then told General Jones that

I then asked General Jones to ask all of the Commanders in Chief of our designated and specified Commands, as well as DIA and others, to be on the alert for any activity of any kind that might be interpreted as the Soviets or anyone else trying to take advantage of the situation, or proceeding in accordance with any sort of plan or activity that might involve hostile action of any sort against the United States.

General Jones reported that [REDACTED]

I returned to the Situation Room and noticed everyone watching the television screen, upon which Al Haig had appeared, and was responding to questions about the Presidential succession and the President's condition. I said (to no one in particular), "I wonder why they're running an old tape of Al Haig's." Someone responded that it was not a tape, that Al Haig was in the press room. I said, "But I thought he was right here."

When Haig stated that the line of succession was from the President to Vice President to Secretary of State, someone said "That's a mistake." Haig was now saying that no alert had been given or contemplated and that none was necessary.

Shortly thereafter, Haig returned to the Situation Room and said we should all act in accordance with the statements he had just made.

I said, "Al, one problem with that is that you should know I have already ordered an increase, although a very small one, in the alert conditions of the Strategic air crews", and I then reported my call to General Jones.

Haig said, "Did you do this simply because of [REDACTED] the incident?" I said that I did it because of the incident and because I did not know whether it was simply an isolated incident or the opening episode of some coordinated plan, and that [REDACTED] mentioned above had indeed been part of the reason.

He pressed again, stating in effect that the only reason I had changed [REDACTED]

I said that, No, it was because I did not know enough about the whole matter at that time, and that it seemed to me a prudent and necessary thing to do. He argued that the fact that I had done so might get out and would tend to discredit his previous statement on television.

I replied that [REDACTED]

I responded that it was my understanding that I had to make decisions in that field and that the decision I had made represented my best judgment. He said that I should read the Constitution (he did not add "buddy" as has been reported in some of the press). More reports were now coming in from phone calls to Dick Allen and others and the matter was dropped. Dick, or someone else, about this time reported that the President was now in surgery. Bill French Smith said he had more information about the gun and the assailant.

I called Ed Meese at the hospital and he confirmed that the President was in surgery. Ed wanted to know the name of the assailant and I relayed the information to him that Bill Smith had provided to the group in the Situation Room. [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] I also reported to Ed Meese the additional alert I had put into effect and that Al Haig had felt this should not have been done, but that I continued to believe it was a small but necessary precaution taken until we had an opportunity to receive reports from various commands around the world, and from other sources.

Ed Meese concurred and he advised again that the Vice President was expected to arrive now about 6:30, and that very preliminarily one of the doctors had advised Ed that the President appeared to be in good condition and that the doctors were confident the wound would not be fatal, but that the surgery was considered necessary.

I then called General Jones again who reported that all [REDACTED] We discussed the fact that a NORAD exercise had been planned for the next day with a simulated incoming missile attack. We both concluded immediately that this exercise should be cancelled. I inquired as to whether any messages had been received from [REDACTED] and was told that none had, and there were no other reports of any unusual nature. One of the [REDACTED]

Bill French Smith by this time had a zerox copy of the statute relating to Presidential succession and was discussing the alternatives of the President transferring authority to the Vice President in the event of the President's disability, or in the event the President was not in condition to transmit authority, that the decision would then be made by the Vice President and the majority of the Cabinet. At this time I noticed that Secretary Block and Secretary Edwards, and I think Secretary Baldrige, had come into the Situation Room.

The discussion flowed back and forth with attention being divided between reports on the television screen and conversation about the arrival of the Vice President, and the points that should be made in briefing him. Admiral Murphy (who had been in the room from the beginning) was making a list of points to bring to the Vice President's attention when he arrived, including such matters as tomorrow's schedule, the Constitutional provisions Bill Smith had just mentioned, the alert condition of the Armed Forces, and a draft of a public statement to be made.

Secretary Regan had information about the Secret Service and reported that he had reports tracing the gun through the Treasury tax people. He also reported that there were no unusual incidents around the country that had been reported to the Secret Service. At about this time, it was reported on television that Jim Brady had died from his wounds. This was corrected in 10 to 15 minutes.

It was now perhaps 5:15 or 5:30.

FOIA(b) (1) I had previously called Deputy Secretary Carlucci and advised him of the status and also of the provisions I had taken [REDACTED]. I then called the National Military Command Center to see if any further information had been received, which it had not. General Jones called me to advise the same thing, and a number of other messages were coming in for other people. I talked to Ed Meese again who reported that the surgery had been completed about 5:30 and that the preliminary indications were that the President had come through extremely well. The President was in the intensive care unit. George Bush was expected at Andrews at 6:30 and would then go to the Vice Presidential residence and then come to the Situation Room, being expected about 7:00.

In the Situation Room, Dick Allen was going over a list of additional points to be presented to the Vice President including tomorrow's schedule, and the desirability of having a Cabinet meeting in the morning, and the fact that the President had been scheduled to meet with the Congressional Leadership. I said I thought it would be very important for these meetings, both the

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Cabinet and the meeting with the Congressional Leadership to be held as scheduled. Al Haig said that Von Agt, the Prime Minister of the Netherlands, was due for various meetings and that he felt there should be no attempt to postpone those meetings.

Jim Baker had come to the Situation Room now and reported that the President had actually lost almost 4 pints of blood, that he said when he saw Mrs. Reagan, "Honey, I forgot to duck", and that on the way into the operating room he had winked when he saw Baker and Meese standing by and put his thumbs up indicating that everything would be alright. Even though because of the oxygen mask and the anesthesia apparatus he was not able to talk, he did smile on his way into the surgery.

I checked again with the Military Command Center and General Jones on the secure phone and was advised that the [REDACTED] that there had been no incidents of any kind reported from anywhere around the world and that [REDACTED]

I told General Jones to advise the Commanders in Chief of the specified and designated Commands that the shooting was apparently an isolated incident, and that no information to the contrary had been received, but that they should continue to remain vigilant.

At almost exactly 7 o'clock, the Vice President came to the Situation Room and very calmly assumed the chair at the head of the table. The first question presented to him was that of the Dairy Price Support Bill, the first one passed by this Congress and hence the first one required to be acted on by President Reagan. That Bill was awaiting signature and Tuesday was the last day on which it could be signed. Bill French Smith advised that the Vice President could sign it, but the Vice President said that he wanted to wait until he saw how the President felt tomorrow and that the President might perfectly well be able to sign it. I said I was sure in any event that Congress would reenact such a measure in a matter of one day so as to start a new time period running if necessary.

The Vice President asked for my report on the status of the forces, and I gave it to him. He then (or it may have been Jim Baker) mentioned that a plane was needed for Jim Brady's family to get them from Chicago where they were having trouble

getting space on a commercial airline. I responded that we could take care of that of course. Someone else said that "No, it has been arranged by now". Ed Meese had also arrived with the Vice President and reported on the President's condition and also on the condition of Jim Brady and the others.

The Vice President then asked "What's next?", and we discussed tomorrow's schedule. The Vice President agreed that he would have the National Security Council briefing in the morning normally given to the President, and agreed also with the recommendation that the Cabinet meeting should be held and the Congressional Leadership briefed. It was concluded with very little discussion that instead of the Republican Leadership meeting normally scheduled for the next day, the Leadership briefing should be a bipartisan briefing. The Vice President also agreed that he would meet with Von Agt, the Netherlands Prime Minister, and then said "Let's try to keep everything as normal as possible, including the scheduling."

Don Regan said we should have some reassuring bulletin out before the markets opened and there was general agreement with this. Bill French Smith then reported that all of the FBI reports concurred with the information I had received to the effect that it was a completely isolated incident and that the assassin, Hinckley, with a previous record in Nashville, seemed to be a "Bremmer" type, a reference to the attempted assassin of George Wallace.

There was one suggestion by Jim Baker that perhaps the Cabinet not be called because it called attention to the absence of the President, but the Vice President said "Let's do it and make it a very short meeting so that everyone can get both information and guidance for answering the press."

It was agreed that all statements concerning all of the activities of the afternoon should be made by the White House Press Office and by no one else. The Vice President also asked the group in general, "Please be sure that we level with the American people and give them full and accurate information."

It was at this point, approximately 7:50 p.m., that I telephoned General Jones and told him since none of us had any information to indicate this was anything except an isolated incident by some individual madman.

I asked him to advise the Commanders in Chiefs to be particularly alert for any unusual incidents during the course of the next few days. He reported that the

CONCLUSION

The above is a generalized running account as I remember the events of the afternoon, aided by some rough notes I made at the time. Although there were a number of people doing a number of things more or less simultaneously, there was not any real confusion. The difficult problem was that while there were massive numbers of reports coming in from the wire services, newspapers, and television screens, there was no way of knowing which of these were accurate. For example, when it was announced about 4:30 p.m. that Jim Brady had died and that some "White House spokesman" had confirmed it, some time was spent trying to locate who this person could have been.

Al Haig reported that he was notifying the Embassies to deliver reassuring messages to the foreign governments around the world and some wires from foreign leaders, such as Mrs. Thatcher, and later Brezhnev, were being received. I was making the calls reported above with respect to the status of the Armed Forces, and Bill French Smith was reporting on the legal matters involving Presidential succession, and FBI information about the suspect. Don Regan was reporting about the Secret Service, and tracing out the information relative to the gun.

Someone, I'm not quite sure who, had already initiated phone calls to the former Presidents (it was reported that one complained he had not been notified soon enough), and others, I believe Max Friedersdorf, had notified the Speaker of the House and the President Pro-Tem of the Senate.

For the future, I would recommend that access to the Situation Room be restricted (Dick Allen tried manfully to do this from time to time throughout the afternoon, but there continued to be a constant movement in and out of the Situation Room by various people with messages, requests for phone calls, delivering additional information, etc.)

At no time was there any "violent quarrel" or any major disagreement between Al Haig and me. The conversations as described above were in a low key and represented simply different views as to the necessity and desirability of [REDACTED] I never felt I had, or was supposed to have, "command of the Situation Room", nor did I object to Al Haig's actions.

At no time was any classified information improperly disclosed and at no time was there any discussion of anything connected with the National Command Authority except a recital

of the matters contained in the published Department of Defense Directive on the subject. The "conversations" and direct quotes alleged in the press to have occurred in the Situation Room between Al Haig and me, simply did not take place. At no time did we argue about who had the authority or anything of the kind.

I remained in the White House until about 10:30 that night, when the President was reported to have retired for the night in good condition.

SUBJECT: ASSASSINATION ATTEMPT AGAINST PRESIDENT REAGAN

1. IMMEDIATELY UPON LEARNING THAT PRESIDENT REAGAN HAD BEEN WOUNDED IN MARCH 30 ASSASSINATION ATTEMPT, I PHONED PALACE TO INFORM KING HUSSEIN. QUEEN NOOR, WHO COINCIDENTALLY HAD HEARD THE NEWS AT ABOUT THE SAME TIME AND WAS TRYING TO REACH ME. QUEEN SAID THAT SHE WAS SPEAKING ON BEHALF OF KING HUSSEIN AS WELL AS HERSELF. BOTH WERE DEEPLY SHOCKED BY THIS ATTACK, RELIEVED TO HEAR THAT THE PRESIDENT'S CONDITION APPEARS TO BE STABLE, AND HOPEFUL FOR A SPEEDY RECOVERY.
