ON 3 OCTOBER 1984 IN QUITO, ECUADOR, FOUR ARMED MEMBERS OF THE ALFARO VIVE CARAJO GROUP OVERRAN THE COSTA RICAN EMBASSY AND DELIVERED A LETTER ADDRESSED TO THE COSTA RICAN PRESIDENT. THE LETTER PROTESTED THE KIDNAPING AND TORTURE OF ECUADOREAN MS. ROSA CARDENAS, WHO HAD BEEN SENT BACK TO ECUADOR BY THE COSTA RICAN GOVERNMENT IN SEPTEMBER. THE COSTA RICAN CHARGE REPORTED THAT THE GROUP REMAINED IN THE EMBASSY FOR ABOUT TEN MINUTES. AFTER THEY DELIVERED THE LETTER, THEY CUT THE TELEPHONE LINES, PAINTED THE WALLS RED WITH SEVERAL SLOGANS CONCERNING THE KIDNAPING OF MS. CARDENAS AND LOCKED THE OFFICE OCCUPANTS, INCLUDING THE CHARGE, IN THE BATHROOM BEFORE LEAVING THE EMBASSY. THE GROUP DID NOT THREATEN OR MISTREAT EMBASSY PERSONNEL.
