11:30 a.m. Mrs. Gorbachev arrives Diplomatic Reception Entrance and is greeted outside by MRS. REAGAN.

(Press Pool Coverage)

11:33 a.m. MRS. REAGAN and Mrs. Gorbachev, accompanied by Rex Scouten and Betty Monkman, proceed through Diplomatic Reception Room, turn left into Cross Hall and proceed to portrait of Pat Nixon (last portrait on right).

11:36 a.m. MRS. REAGAN and Mrs. Gorbachev proceed back down Cross Hall (viewing other First Lady portraits along route), up Grand Staircase, into Grand Foyer and proceed to State Dining Room. (If time permits, tour of Vermeil Room, China Room, and Library will be included.)

(Press Pool Coverage - press will proceed up back staircase to pre-position in State Dining Room.)

11:39 a.m. MRS. REAGAN and Mrs. Gorbachev enter State Dining Room and proceed to portrait of Abe Lincoln on West Wall, and other items in room.

(Press Pool Coverage - press will depart State Dining Room through south door into Red Room.)

11:43 a.m. MRS. REAGAN and Mrs. Gorbachev depart the State Dining Room, enter Red Room, and continue tour.

(Press Pool Coverage - press will depart Red Room through south doors into Blue Room.)

11:47 a.m. MRS. REAGAN and Mrs. Gorbachev depart Red Room through north doors, enter Blue Room, and continue tour.

(Press Pool Coverage - press will depart Blue Room through south doors and enter Green Room.)

11:51 a.m. MRS. REAGAN and Mrs. Gorbachev depart Blue Room through north doors, enter Green Room, and continue tour.

(Press Pool Coverage - press will depart Green Room through south doors and enter East Room.)

11:55 a.m. MRS. REAGAN and Mrs. Gorbachev depart Green Room, through Cross Hall doors and enter East Room through center Cross Hall doors. They will proceed to portrait of George Washington.
