On Friday, November 14th, the President and First Lady will be interviewed by Maryland Public Television in the Map Room before they depart for Camp David (approximately 2:30-3:00 p.m.).

The production crew will arrive at the Southwest Gate at 12 noon. Following equipment inspection and clearance, they will proceed along the South Drive to C-9 for unloading of equipment. One of their vehicles will remain on the South Drive and the other vehicle will be there for unloading and loading of equipment only. A uniformed escort should be provided for easy access in and out of the residence.

An electrician will be needed in the Map Room at 12:30 p.m. Also needed: one small bouquet of flowers and one table for equipment.

A glass of hot water for the President and a glass of tap water for the First Lady should be available at 2:15 p.m.



I. PURPOSE

For the President and Mrs. Reagan to tape an interview with Ann Compton for Maryland Public TV.

II. BACKGROUND

Maryland Public TV is producing a documentary on the history of Camp David. The program is scheduled to air next Spring. MPTV has compiled footage from presidential libraries and archives dating back to President Franklin Roosevelt, as well as Navy film footage from the Reagan Administration. The President and Mrs. Reagan will be the only President or First Lady doing a contemporary interview for this documentary. All other presidencies have been represented by either family members, former staff members or historians.

Ann Compton hopes to have the President and Mrs. Reagan comment on their personal feelings about Camp David. Possible questions and topics are attached.
