IN THE FOLLOWING CRITICAL AREAS:

- 1. AT THE NATIONAL BANK OF LIBERIA TO OVERSEE THE COLLECTION AND DISBURSEMENT OF OFFSHORE FUNDS, AND ESPECIALLY OF THE 25 PERCENT OF EXPORT RECEIPTS THAT WILL BECOME AVAILABLE AS OF MAY 1, 1986;
- 2. IN THE REVENUE DEPARTMENT AT THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE TO OVERSEE THE COLLECTION OF GOVERNMENT REVENUE; AND
- 3. IN THE EXPENDITURE AND DEBT MANAGEMENT DEPARTMENT AT THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE TO ENHANCE EXPENDITURE CONTROL.

WHILE THESE MEASURES MAY NOT PROVIDE A CURE-ALL FOR OUR ECONOMIC PROBLEMS, WE BELIEVE THEY CONSTITUTE A SOUND BASIS FOR STABILIZING THE ECONOMY IN THE SHORT RUN AND WILL LAY THE FDUNDATION FOR INITIATING THE MEDIUM TO LONG TERM RECOVERY AND GROWTH PROGRAM FOR LIBERIA.

IT IS PLEASING TO NOTE THAT WE HAVE ALREADY BEGUN TO SEE SIGNS OF IMPROVEMENT AND THE REGAINING OF CONFIDENCE BY BUSINESSES AND THE BANKING SECTOR.

IT IS THEREFORE OUR RESPONSIBILIT. ALL OF US, AS TRUE LIBERIANS, IRRESPECTIVE OF POLITICAL, ECONOMIC OR SOCIAL BACKGROUND, TO WORK TOGETHER TO DEVELOP OUR COUNTRY AND MAKE LIFE WORTH LIVING FOR ALL.

GOVERNMENT IS AWARE THAT A MAJOR PROBLEM HAS BEEN THAT OF PAYMENT OF SALARIES TO PUBLIC SERVANTS.

I WANT TO LET OUR PEOPLE KNOW THAT THIS MATTER IS OF SERIOUS CONCERN TO US AND IS PERSISTENTLY CLAIMING OUR ATTENTION.

WHEN YOU DO NOT GET PAID, YOU CANNOT PAY YOUR RENT;
YOU CANNOT BUY FOOD; YOUR CHILDREN'S SCHOOL FEES
CANNOT BE PAID. CONSEQUENTLY, THE LANDLORDS DO NOT
HAVE FUNDS TO MEET THEIR OBLIGATIONS; THE MARKET
WOMEN LOSE CUSTOMERS AND THE VICIOUS CYCLE CONTINUES.

ALTHOUGH WE ARE AWARE OF ALL OF THESE PROBLEMS, WE ARE FORCED AT TIMES TO SEEK YOUR UNDERSTANDING AND SYMPATHY FOR THE PROBLEMS GOVERNMENT FACES AS WELL.

WHEN THE TIMES ARE GOOD, WE ALL SHOULD ENJOY AND WHEN TIMES ARE HARD WE SHOULD ALL COME TOGETHER AND TRY TO WITHSTAND THE DIFFICULTIES.

I WOULD LIKE TO BELIEVE THAT WE HAVE SEEN THE MOST DIFFICULT OF TIMES. I BELIEVE OUR PEOPLE CAN NOW LOOK FORWARD WITH HOPE FOR A BETTER TOMORROW.

WHILE I HAVE ALWAYS BEEN CAUTIOUS ABOUT MAKING PROMISES, I AM WILLING TO TAKE THE RISK IN ASSURING ALL OUR PUBLIC SERVANTS THAT IF THE PRESENT TREND CONTINUES, SALARIES TO ALL EMPLOYEES IN GOVERNMENT WOULD BE MADE CURRENT BY JUNE THIS YEAR.

FELLOW CITIZENS, YOUR EXCELLENCIES, DISTINGUISHED LADIES AND GENTLEMEN: IT MAY WELL BE THAT MANY OF LIFE'S FAILURES ARE DUE TO THE MISTAKEN IDEA OF BEING CONTENT WITH PAST ACHIEVEMENTS, WHICH, LIKE PAST BLESSINGS, IS NOT ENOUGH.

NUMAN MATURE BEING WHAT IT IS, WE SURELY DO NOT HAVE A MONOPOLY OF SHORTCOMINGS. BUT OUR DETERMINATION TO TAKE ADVANTAGE AND SEIZE EVERY OPPORTUNITY TO IMPROVE SHOULD RECEIVE THE APPROBATION OF ALL PEOPLE AND EARN THE RESPECT AND RECOGNITION OF THE WORLD.

AT 11:98 A.M. ON MAY 2, PRESIDENT DOE DELIVERED A RADIO ADDRESS TO THE NATION. PRESENT IN THE MANSION WERE MEMBERS OF THE CABINET, THE LEGISLATURE AND THE DIPLOMATIC CORPS. THE TEXT OF THE ADDRESS FOLLOWS.

QTE MR. VICE PRESIDENT; MR. SPEAKER AND HONORABLE MEMBERS OF THE LEGISLATURE; MEMBERS OF THE CABINET; MR. ACTING CHIEF JUSTICE; MR. CHIEF OF STAFF AND MEMBERS OF THE ARMED FORCES OF LIBERIA; MR. DOYEN AND MEMBERS OF THE DIPLOMATIC CORPS; MEMBERS OF THE CLERGY, PRELATES; DISTINGUISHED LADIES AND GENTLEMEN; FELLOW CITIZENS; FRIENDS: THROUGH THE TENDER GUIDING HANDS AND MERCIFUL WILL OF THE ALMIGHTY OUR LIVES HAVE BEEN SPARED, AND WE ARE ABLE TO STAND BEFORE YOU TODAY.

IN RECENT TIMES, OUR NATION HAS BEEN CONFRONTED WITH GRAVE EVENTS WHICH HAVE SOMETIMES TENDED TO MAKE US BELIEVE THAT OUR ENEMY - THE DEVIL WAS GOING TO BE IN CHARGE OF THE RACE COURSE OF LIFE. BUT, ABNORMAL THINGS ARE ONLY PHASES OF THE EBB AND FLOW OF THE GREAT RIVER OF LIFE.

A LITTLE OVER ONE HUNDRED DAYS AG. THROUGH DIVINE PROVIDENCE AND THE OPERATION OF LAW, A NEW ERA IN THE ANNALS OF OUR MATION WAS USHERED INTO BEING.

SURELY WE HAVE REASON TO THANK GOD AND TAKE COURAGE FOR HIM HAVING GIVEN US STRENGTH TO CONTINUE THIS GREAT TASK OF NATION-BUILDING.

MY FELLOW CITIZENS: I HAVE COME TO SPEAK TO YOU THIS MORNING CONCERNING A MATTER WHICH IS OF MAJOR CONCERN TO ALL LIBERIANS - YOUNG AND OLD, MALE AND FEMALE, PEOPLE FROM EVERY WALK OF LIFE; THIS MATTER HAS TO DO WITH THE STATE OF OUR ECONOMY.

AS OUR NATION TRAVELS ALONG THE PATH OF CONSTITUTED GOVERNMENT, WE NOW FIND OURSELVES CHALLENGED BY SEVERE ECONOMIC PROBLEMS, WHICH TEND TO THREATEN OUR SOVEREIGNTY.

THE NATION'S ECONOMY HAS APPROACHED A POINT WHERE BOLD AND URGENT ACTIONS ARE REQUIRED IF WE ARE

WHILE A SERIES OF COURAGEOUS DECISIONS HAVE BEEN TAKEN OVER THE PAST FIVE YEARS AND STABILIZATION PROGRAMS UNDERTAKEN WITH EXTERNAL ASSISTANCE, THE ECONOMIC SITUATION OF OUR COUNTRY REMAINS CRITICAL AND THE STANDARD OF LIVING OF OUR PEOPLE CONTINUES TO BE SEVERELY ERODED. REDUCING THIS BUDGETARY INBALANCE IS, IN OUR VIEW, A PREREQUISITE FOR ECONOMIC RECOVERY AND REQUIRES THE RIGOROUS IMPLEMENTATION OF POLICY MEASURES DESIGNED TO ATTAIN THIS OBJECTIVE.
WHILE A MEDIUM TO LONG TERM ECONOMIC RECOVERY PROGRAM IS BEING DEVELOPED FOR ADOPTION BY GOVERNMENT, THE FOLLOWING CONSTITUTES A PROGRAM FOR SHORT-TERM RECOVERY AND WILL RECEIVE OUR FULLEST SUPPORT.

THE ACHIEVEMENT OF THE SHORT RUN GOALS OF ECONOMIC RECOVERY AND THE LAYING OF THE FOUNDATION FOR SUSTAINED DEVELOPMENT REQUIRE THAT CERTAIN FUNDAMENTAL CHANGES BE IMMEDIATELY INSTITUTED IN THE REVENUE COLLECTION MACHINERY TO CORRECT THOSE FACTORS WHICH ACCOUNT FOR SHORTFALLS IN COLLECTION. TOWARDS THIS END, THE BUDGET FOR THE SECOND SEMESTER OF 1985/1986 HAS BEEN PROGRAMMED TO CONSOLIDATE ALL PUBLIC REVENUES. THOSE REVENUES PREVIOUSLY EARMARKED FOR SPECIFIC PURPOSES ARE TO BE REMITTED TO GOVERNMENT AND DISBURSED THROUGH THE NORMAL BUDGETARY PROCESS.

AT THE SAME TIME, THE PRACTICE OF OFFSETTING GOVERNMENT OBLIGATIONS OUTSIDE OF THE BUDGET AGAINST TAX REVENUE OF SOME PUBLIC CORPORATIONS MUST BE DISCONTINUED IMMEDIATELY.

THE MANAGEMENT OF THESE ESTABLISHMENTS HAVE BEEN DIRECTED NOT TO HONOR REQUESTS FROM ANY MINISTRY OR AGENCY. HOREOVER, THE MANAGEMENT OF THE LIBERIA PETROLEUM REFINING COMPANY HAS BEEN INFORMED THAT LIFTING OF PETROLEUM PRODUCTS MUST BE DONE ON A CASH-DNLY BASIS.

IN DRDER TO PROPERLY RECONCILE ACCOUNT WITH THE PETRO-CHEMICAL INDUSTRIES (PCI) FOR GOVERNMENT'S FUEL CONSUMPTION, AN AUDIT HAS BEEN COMMISSIONED TO BE UNDERTAKEN BY AN INDEPENDENT PUBLIC ACCOUNTING

IN OUR CONTINUING EFFORT TO CONSOLIDATE THE REVENUE BASE, GOVERNMENT HAS NOTED WITH CONCERN THAT REVENUE-GENERATING ENTITIES SUCH AS THE LIBERIA NATIONAL LOTTERIES ARE PRESENTLY NOT SUPERVISED BY THE APPROPRIATE GOVERNMENT AGENCIES. WE HAVE ACCORDINGLY GIVEN DIRECTIVES FOR THE LIBERIA NATIONAL LOTTERIES TO BE CLASSIFIED AS A STATE ENTERPRISE AND SUPERVISED BY THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE.

AN IMMEDIATE AUDIT HAS ALSO BEEN COMMISSIONED TO ESTABLISH AN INVENTORY OF REVENUE ARREARS DUE THE TREASURY

NUMEROUS COMMISSIONS AND WORKING GROUPS SET UP TO REVIEW THE NATION'S ECONOMIC PROBLEMS HAVE BEEN CRITICAL OF PERFORMANCE IN THE CUSTOMS AREA. THOSE REPORTS HAVE UNANIHOUSLY SUPPORTED OUR SUSPICIONS OF UNDER-INVOICING OF IMPORTS AND LEAKAGES IN AFTER CAREFUL ANALYSIS, WE HAVE ENDORSED THE IMPLEMENTATION OF A COMPREHENSIVE IMPORT SURVEILLANCE SCHEMF.

THE SCHEME IS BEING UNDERTAKEN IN COLLABORATION WITH AN INTERNATIONAL FIRM WITH AN EXTENSIVE RECORD OF EXPERIENCE IN THIS AREA.

A NUMBER OF CORRECTIVE MEASURES ARE BEING IMPLEMENTED IN THE SHORT RUN TO GUARANTEE THAT POLICIES SUCH AS THE IMPORT INSPECTION SCHEME, WHICH HAVE INTERMEDIATE AND LONG-TERM BENEFITS, WILL BEAR FRUIT.

IT IS OUR MOPE THAT BUSINESSES AND DTHERS CONCERNED WILL COOPERATE IN THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THIS SCHEME DURING THIS INITIAL PERIOD.

THE ISSUANCE OF DUTY DRAWBACK CERTIFICATES HAVE BEEN CANCELLED AND DUTY-FREE PRIVILEGES TO THE PX OPERATIONS AND DUTY-FREE SHOPS ABOLISHED.

THE OPERATIONS OF THE NATIONAL INVESTMENT COMMISSION INVOLVE GRANTING OF TAX CONCESSION AND INCENTIVE CONTRACTS AS INDUCEMENTS FOR INVESTORS. THOSE INSTRUMENTS BY WHICH INCENTIVES ARE OFFERED HAVE DIRECT IMPLICATIONS FOR THE REVENUE AND TAX LAWS OF LIBERIA.

CONSIDERING THAT THESE TAX LAWS ARE ADMINISTERED BY THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE IN CLOSE COLLABORATION WITH OTHER AGENCIES OF GOVERNMENT, I WILL BE SUBMITTING A BILL TO THE LEGISLATURE TO RECONSTITUTE THE NATIONAL INVESTMENT COMMISSION TO INCLUDE THE

DISTINGUISHED LADIES AND GENTLEMEN, MY FELLOW CITIZENS: CONSIDERING THAT POLICIES AIMED AT INCREASING REVENUES DO NOT YIELD CONCRETE RESULTS IN THE VERY SHORT RUN, AND IN OUR EFFORT TO REDUCE THE DEFICIT, GOVERNMENT HAS INSTITUTED A SERIES OF POLICY MEASURES TO CURTAIL THE BUDGET AND ELIMINATE EXTRA-BUDGETARY EXPENDITURES.

WAGES AND SALARIES WHICH CONSTITUTE THE LARGEST SINGLE EXPENDITURE ITEM IN THE RECURRENT BUDGET HAVE BEEN REDUCED FROM \$16 MILLION TO \$7 MILLION PER MONTH AS A RESULT OF THE SALARY REDUCTION AND RETIREMENT EXERCISE INTRODUCED IN DECEMBER 1985, WHILE THE FREEZE ON DOMESTIC ARREARS PAYMENT CONTINUES TO BE IN FORCE.

NOTWITHSTANDING THESE EFFORTS, FINANCIAL
DISCIPLINE CONTINUES TO ELUDE US AS EVIDENCED BY
THE ESCALATION OF THE OVERALL BUDGET DEFICIT FROM
A PROJECTED \$54.7 HILLION TO AN ACTUAL OF \$78 HILLION
REPRESENTING 7 PERCENT OF GDP FOR THE FIRST HALF
OF FISCAL YEAR 1985/1986; THIS IS CLEARLY AN
UNITENABLE SITUATION.

PUBLIC CORPORATIONS

THE RECORD OF POOR FINANCIAL PERFORMANCE, AND INDEED THE FAILURES OF SOME OF OUR PUBLIC CORPORATIONS HAVE CONTRIBUTED SIGNIFICANTLY TO THE CURRENT ECONOMIC CRISIS. FOR A VARIETY OF REASONS, MANY PUBLIC CORPORATIONS HAVE NOT BEEN ABLE TO OPERATE VIABLY, EFFICIENTLY, AND IN A PROFITABLE MANNER.

A DIRECT RESULT OF THIS STATE OF AFFAIRS IS THAT THESE CORPORATIONS HAVE BECOME A DRAIN ON THE ALREADY SCARCE RESOURCES OF GOVERNMENT, INSTEAD OF BEING POSITIVE CONTRIBUTORS TO THE NATIONAL INCOME AND WELFARE.

IT IS TOWARDS THIS END THAT ON MARCH 18, 1986, I GAVE EXECUTIVE APPROVAL TO AM ACT PASSED BY THE MATIONAL LEGISLATURE WHICH AUTHORIZED THE PRESIDENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF LIBERIA TO DEVISE APPROPRIATE AND MECESSARY MEASURES TO WHOLLY OR PARTIALLY PRIVATIZE CERTAIN STATE ENTERPRISES IN ORDER TO IMPROVE THEIR OPERATIONAL EFFICIENCY, PRODUCTIVE COMPETENCE AND REDUCE THEIR DEPENDENCE UPON GOVERNMENT SUBSIDIES.

TO DATE, A NUMBER OF THESE ENTERPRISES HAVE BEEN IDENTIFIED FOR INITIAL SCRUTINY AND A PLAN OF ACTION AND WORK PROGRAM HAVE BEEN ADOPTED BY GOVERNMENT. EFFORTS ARE PRESENTLY UNDERWAY TO SEEK FUNDING THROUGH THE WORLD BANK FOR TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE TO BE MADE AVAILABLE TO GOVERNMENT THROUGH THE BUREAU OF STATE ENTERPRISES FOR THE PRIVATIZATION PROGRAM.

POLICY DECISIONS REGARDING THE FEASIBILITY AND DEGREE OF DIVESTMENT, AND NEGOTIATIONS OF FINAL ARRANGEMENTS WITH SUCCESSFUL APPLICANTS FOR RECOMMENDATION TO GOVERNMENT WILL BE ENTRUSTED TO A PRIVATIZATION COMMISSION WHICH IS TO BE ESTABLISHED SHORTLY.

WE WISH TO STRESS HERE THAT GOVERNMENT'S APPRDACH TO PRIVATIZATION SHALL BE STRICTLY PROFESSIONAL, AND SHALL BE GUIDED ALWAYS BY THE PRINCIPLE THAT ANY SUCH ACTIVITY MUST REDOUND TO THE ULTIMATE 6547 AF75

DEBT SERVICE

DISTINGUISHED LADIES AND CTITLEMEN: OF GREAT CONCERN TO US HAS BEEN THE STERNAL DEBT-SERVICE ARREARS AND ITS ATTENDANT MOVERSE CONSEQUENCES FOR OUR ABILITY TO ACQUIRE THE ADDITIONAL FINANCIAL RESOURCES WHICH WE SO DESPERATELY NEED.

WMILE THE MAGNITUDE OF THE AMOUNTS INVOLVED AND THE SEVERITY OF THE FOREIGN EXCHANGE CRISIS WHICH CONFRONTS US MAKE IT IMPOSSIBLE TO ELIMINATE EXTERNAL PAYMENT ARREARS IN THE SHORT RUN, IT IS NEVERTHELESS ABSOLUTELY ESSENTIAL THAT WE MAKE EFFORTS TO PAY THAT WHICH IS POSSIBLE.

FOR IT IS ONLY BY SO DOING THAT WE WILL REGAIN THE CONFIDENCE OF OUR CREDITORS WHICH IS NECESSARY FOR REQUESTING FURTHER ASSISTANCE, INCLUDING OBBT

I MAVE ACCORDINGLY DIRECTED THE MINISTER OF FINANCE TO DEVELOP A PRIORITY LIST OF DEBT-SERVICE PAYMENTS DUE THIS YEAR; THIS PROCEDURE MUST BE BASED ON DEVELOPMENTAL CONSIDERATIONS SUCH THAT DEBT REPAYMENT BECOMES A PRODUCTIVE ENDEAVOR. THE SPECIAL ACCOUNT INTO WHICH A PERCENTAGE OF OFFSHORE REVENUES ARE TO BE DEPOSITED IN ORDER TO FACILITATE DEBT-SERVICE PAYMENTS MUST BE RESTORED AND REPLEMISHED.

WE CANNOT OVER-EMPHASIZE THE FACT THAT URGENT DEBT OBLIGATIONS MUST BE HONORED IMMEDIATELY. THE SURRENDER OF 25 PERCENT OF LIBERIAN EXPORTERS' RECEIPTS TO THE MATIONAL BANK EFFECTIVE MAY 1, 1986, WILL ENHANCE OUR ABILITY TO SERVICE OUR OEBT. IN OUR OPINION, THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THIS SCHEME. WILL SERVE AS AN IMPORTANT FACTOR IN STIMULATING ECONOMIC ACTIVITIES AND THEREBY CONTRIBUTE TOWARDS THE OVERALL RECOVERY.
