1. SEDEET - ENTIRE TEXT.

2. IN VIEW OF LIBYA'S CONTINUED PRESENCE IN CHAD DESPITE AGREEMENT WITH FRANCE TO WITHDRAW. OVERTURES TO IMPROVE RELATIONS WITH A NUMBER OF AFRICAN STATES SUCH AS MAURITANIA AND GAMBIA, APPARENT SUCCESSES IN EUROPE (VISITS TO SPAIN AND MALTA) AND IN NORTH AFRICA (MOROCCO UNION), AF BUREAU SPECULATES THAT QADHAFI WILL LOOK FOR NEW POLITICAL AND/OR MILITARY GAINS IN AFRICA.

3. TO PROVIDE POLICY MAKERS WITH POSSIBLE SCENARIOS, INR WILL PREPARE AN ASSESSMENT OF THE MENT OF EXPECTED FROM ANDHAFI OVER THE NEXT SLY MONTHS TO TWO YEARS THE

ASSESSMENT WILL TAKE INTO ACCOUNT OPPORTUNITIES FOR GADHAFI THAT MIGHT ARISE OUT OF AFRICAN MILITARY AND ECONOMIC WEAKNESSES AS WELL AS CONSTRAINTS ON HIS ACTIONS, EITHER BECAUSE OF LIMITATIONS AT HOME OR PRESSURES FROM OUTSIDE. ASSESSMENT WILL BE PREPARED JOINTLY BY INR/AA, INR/NESA AND INR/WEA.

IN GENERAL TERMS, WE WOULD APPRECIATE HEARING WHAT ADDRESSEES CONSIDER THE MOST LIKELY LIBYAN ACTIONS AS WELL AS LIKELY RESPONSES OF HOST COUNTRIES. WE HOPE TO FINISH THE ASSESSMENT BY EARLY FEBRUARY AND WOULD APPRECIATE EMBASSY COMMENTS BY JANUARY 21.
