U.S. REPORTED DENYING INTELLIGENCE TO NEW ZEALAND

LONDON (UPI) -- NEW ZEALAND IS BEING DENIED ACCESS TO TOP-LEVEL U.S. INTELLIGENCE REPORTS ON THE SOVIET UNION AS A REPRISAL FOR ITS REFUSAL TO ALLOW PORT ACCESS TO A U.S. DESTROYER, JANE'S DEFENSE WEEKLY SAID TUESDAY.

THE AUTHORITATIVE DEFENSE PUBLICATION SAID NEW ZEALAND WAS CUT FROM THE RECEIPT LIST OF THE TOP-LEVEL INTELLIGENCE, MONITORED FROM SOVIET RADIO, AS SOON AS PRIME MINISTER DAVID LANGE BARRED THE USS BUCHANAN EARLIER THIS MONTH.

LANGE SAID THE SHIP COULD BOCK IN NEW ZEALAND UNLESS WASHINGTON GUARANTEED IT CARRIED NO NUCLEAR WEAPONS.

IN WASHINGTON, A STATE DEPARTMENT SPOKESMAN HAD NO COMMENT ON THE JANE'S REPORT.

IN A REPORT FROM AUSTRALIA, JANE'S SAID THE INTELLIGENCE BEING DENIED NEW ZEALAND IS GATHERED UNDER A U.S.-BRITISH AGREEMENT FOR MONITORING SOVIET MILITARY AND DIPLOMATIC RADIO TRAFFIC IN THE PACIFIC.

TEXT) THE FOREIGN MINISTER, MR HAYDEN, HAS STRONGLY DEFENDED RUSTRALIA'S RIGHT TO CONTNUE AN EXCHANGE OF INTELLIGENCE INFORMATION WITH NEW ZEALAND. SPEAKING IN CANBERRA TODAY, MR HAYDEN DECLINED TO COMMENT DIRECTLY ON OVERSEAS REPORTS THAT UNITED STATES HAVE STOPPED SUPPLYING NEW ZEALAND WITH INTELLIGENCE INFORMATION AS A RESULT OF THE ANZUS DISPUTE OVER NUCLEAR-CAPABLE SHIPS. HOWEVER HE STRESSED THAT AUSTRALIA RETAINED THE RIGHT TO SHARE INTELLIGENCE INFORMATION WITH ITS TRANS-TASMAN NEIGHBOR.

WASHINGTON OFFICIALS HAVE STRONGLY CRITICIZED THE NEW ZEALAND GOVERNMENT FOR ITS DECISION TO REFUSE PORT FACILITIES TO AMERICAN NUCLEAR-ARMED OR -POWERED WARSHIPS. THE AMERICANS SAY NEW ZEALAND'S ACTION GOES AGAINST THE SPIRIT OF THE ANZUS MILITARY ALLIANCE WHICH LINKS THE UNITED STATES, AUSTRALIA, AND NEW ZEALAND.

THE AUTHORITATIVE LONDON PUBLICATION JANE'S DEFENSE WEEKLY SAYS THE AMERICAN INTELLIGENCE INFORMATION NOW BEING DENIED TO NEW ZEALAND IS GATHERED UNDER AN AMERICAN-BRITISH ARRANGEMENT FOR MONITORING SOVIET MILITARY AND DIPLOMATIC RADIO TRAFFIC IN THE PACIFIC.

IN CANBERRA TODAY, MR HAYDEN REFUSED TO BE DRAWN ON THE REPORT BUT SAID IF SUCH A MEASURE WAS TAKEN AGAINST NEW ZEALAND'S LANGE GOVERNMENT THERE WOULD BE IMPLICATIONS FOR AUSTRALIA. HE SAID IT WOULD BE ONE OF THE MAFTERS CONSIDERED IN A PAPER TO BE PREPARED BY HIMSELF AND THE DEFENSE MINISTER, MR BEALZLEY, ON THE OPERATION OF THE ANZUS TREATY.

MR HAYDEN SAID AUSTRALIA MAINTAINED A STRONG COMMITMENT TO NEW ZEALAND, AND HE EMPHASIZED THE IMPORTANCE OF TRADING, CULTURAL, AND HISTORIC LINKS BETWEEN THE TWO COUNTRIES. HE SAID NOTHING HAD OCCURRED WHICH IN ANY WAY IMPAIRED CAMBERRA'S COMMITMENT TO WELLINGTON.

1. FOLLOWING IS THE FULL TEXT OF AN ARTICLE WHICH APPEARED ON THE FRONT PAGE OF THE FEBRUARY 25 EDITION

OF "THE AUSTRALIAN." THE ARTICLE WAS ENTITLED
"U.S. READY TO CUT INTELLIGENCE FLOW TO NEW ZEALAND"
AND APPEARED UNDER THE BY-LINE OF DEFENSE CORRESPONDENT
PETER YOUNG.

2. BEGIN TEXT:

THE UNITED STATES IS ABOUT TO GIVE NOTICE TO NEW ZEALAND THAT IT WILL CUT OFF THE FLOW OF INTELLIGENCE UNDER THE ANZUS TREATY, ACCORDING TO RELIABLE SOURCES.

NOTICE MAY BE SERVED ON WELLINGTON AS EARLY AS TODAY. THIS WOULD PLACE NEW PRESSURE ON THE ANZUS ALLIANCE AND POSE MAJOR POLITICAL PROBLEMS FOR THE HAWKE GOVERNMENT IN HAVING TO CHOOSE BETWEEN THE U.S. AND NEW ZEALAND.

WHEN CONFRONTED WITH THIS POSSIBILITY IN CANBERRA LAST WEEK, THE MINISTER FOR FOREIGN AFFAIRS, MR. HAYDEN. SAID AUSTRALIA WOULD RETAIN ITS RIGHTS TO DEAL WITH NEW ZEALAND ON A UNILATERAL BASIS, EMPHASIZING THAT AUSTRALIA HAD ITS OWN INTELLIGENCE CAPABILITY.

AUSTRALIA, HOWEVER, HAS ONLY A REGIONAL CAPABILITY AND IS DEPENDENT ON THE FLOW OF INFORMATION FROM THE U.S. SYSTEM FOR ANY WIDER ASSESSMENTS.

IT IS DIFFICULT TO SEE HOW THE TWO COULD BE SEPARATED AND WHETHER THE AMERICANS WOULD CONTINUE TO ALLOW FULL ACCESS TO AUSTRALIA IN THE EVENT OF A SEPARATE ARRANGEMENT BETWEEN AUSTRALIA AND NEW ZEALAND.

ANOTHER PROBLEM IS THAT NEW ZEALAND INTELLIGENCE OFFICERS ARE CLOSELY INTEGRATED INTO THE ACQUISITION

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AND ANALYTICAL AREAS OF THE DEFENSE SIGNALS DIRECTORATE (DSD) WHICH IS THE MAIN CONDUIT FOR U.S. ELECTRONIC INTELLIGENCE. NEW ZEALAND ALSO HAS CLOSE TIES WITH THE AUSTRALIAN HUMAN INTELLIGENCE (HUMINT) ORGANIZATIONS, ASIS, AUSTRALIA'S SECRET INTELLIGENCE SERVICE: AND ASIO.

IF AUSTRALIA CHOSE TO MAINTAIN THESE LINKS OR TO PROVIDE SEPARATE ACCESS, THE AMERICANS COULD EITHER SCALE DOWN THE LEVELS OF INTELLIGENCE, AS IT IS BELIEVED THEY DID TO THE WHITLAM GOVERNMENT, OR CUT OFF AUSTRALIA COMPLETELY.

INTELLIGENCE ANALYSTS IN CANBERRA BELIEVE THE LAST COURSE IS UNLIKELY BECAUSE OF THE VALUE OF THE AUSTRALIAN REGIONAL INTELLIGENCE EXPERTISE AND THE INCREASING IMPORTANCE OF THE U.S. BASES IN AUSTRALIA. THE U.S., HOWEVER, HAS CONTROL OF THE OVERALL WESTERN INTELLIGENCE "CAKE" AND COULD QUITE EASILY IMPOSE A SELECTIVE LESSENING OF THE IMPORTANCE AND VALUE OF THE FLOW OF INFORMATION.

THE MOVE IS SEEN AS RETALIATION FOR NEW ZEALAND'S REFUSAL TO ACCEPT VISITING NUCLEAR ARMED OR POWERED WARSHIPS AND WOULD THREATEN THE FUTURE OF THE ALLIANCE WHICH DEPENDS ON THE FREE FLOW OF INTELLIGENCE BETWEEN MEMBER NATIONS.

NO OFFICIAL COMMENT WAS MADE OVER THE WEEKEND EITHER IN CANBERRA OR IN WELLINGTON BUT IT IS KNOWN BOTH GOVERNMENTS ARE AWARE OF THE POLTIICAL PENALTIES OF EVEN A PARTIAL WITHDRAWAL OF SUPPORT BY THE U.S. FROM THE ALLIANCE.

THIS LAST WEEK SAW AN ORCHESTRATED DEMONSTRATION OF SUPPORT FOR THE ALLIANCE BY THE NEW ZEALAND AND

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AUSTRALIAN MINISTERS FOR DEFENSE IN THE ANNOUNCEMENT OF THE HASTILY PREPARED JOINT NEW ZEALAND-AUSTRALIAN BT
