1. (U) FOREIGN MINISTER HAYDEN ON FEBRUARY 14 ISSUED A CLARIFYING STATEMENT DENYING THAT HIS FEBRUARY 13 PRESS CONFERENCE REMARKS (REFTEL) HAD IN ANY WAY BEEN INTENDED AS A THREAT TO CLOSE THE JOINT FACILITIES IF THE U.S. CUT OFF INTELLIGENCE-SHARING WITH AUSTRALIA.

2. (C) COMMENT: HAYDEN'S CLARIFICATION RECEIVED ONLY SCANT MEDIA ATTENTION (NO ELECTRONIC MEDIA REPORTS OF WHICH WE ARE AWARE, AND SMALL INSIDE-PAGE ARTICLES IN TWO OF THE THREE LEADING DAILIES). NEVERTHELESS, THE STATEMENT IS AS CLOSE TO A RETRACTION AS WE HAVE SEEN FROM THE FOREIGN MINISTER IN RECENT EXPERIENCE, AND AS SUCH INDICATES THAT HE RECOGNIZED THE POTENTIAL SENSITIVITY OF HIS EARLIER COMMENT.
