1. (U) FOREIGN MINISTER HAYDEN ON FEBRUARY 14 ISSUED A CLARIFYING STATEMENT DENYING THAT HIS FEBRUARY 13 PRESS CONFERENCE REMARKS (REFTEL) HAD IN ANY WAY BEEN INTENDED AS A THREAT TO CLDSE THE JOINT FACILITIES IF THE U.S. CUT OFF INTELLIGENCE-SHARING WITH AUSTRALIA.

2. (C) COMMENT: HAYDEN'S CLARIFICATION RECEIVED ONLY SCANT MEDIA ATTENTION (NO ELECTRONIC MEDIA REPORTS OF WHICH WE ARE AWARE, AND SMALL INSIDE-PAGE ARTICLES IN TWO OF THE THREE LEADING DAILIES). NEVERTHELESS, THE STATEMENT IS AS CLOSE TO A RETRACTION AS WE HAVE SEEN FROM THE FOREIGN MINISTER IN RECENT EXPERIENCE, AND AS SUCH INDICATES THAT HE RECOGNIZED THE POTENTIAL SENSITIVITY OF HIS EARLIER COMMENT. END COMMENT.

3. (U) THE FULL TEXT OF THE STATEMENT FOLLOWS: -

BEGIN TEXT:

YESTERDAY, I SAID AT A PRESS COMFERENCE THAT SATISFACTORY INTELLIGENCE ARRANGEMENTS CONTINUED BETWEEN THE UNITED STATES AND AUSTRALIA. I ALSO POINTED OUT THAT THESE ARRANGEMENTS WOULD HAVE TO CONTINUE BECAUSE, IF THEY WERE SUSPENDED, TWO OF THE MOST IMPORTANT FACILITIES THE U.S. HAS, IN ASSOCIATION WITH AUSTRALIA, JUST ABOUT ANYWHERE IN THE WORLD WOULD HAVE TO CLOSE DOWN.

THIS IS A SIMPLE STATEMENT OF OPERATIONAL FACT WHICH Should have been abundantly obvious to any commentator who had kept abreast of public statements on how these facilities were required to function.

THE POLICY OF THE LABOR PARTY AND THE PRACTICE AND PRONOUNCEMENTS OF THIS AND EARLIER GOVERNMENTS AT BOTH ENDS OF THE POLITICAL SPECTRUM HAVE PRESCRIBED THE RIGHTS OF FULL AUSTRALIAN ACCESS TO ALL LEVELS OF THE OPERATION OF THESE FACILITIES, TO MATERIAL PROCESSED BY THE FACILITIES AND TO THEIR PRODUCT. CONTROL OF THE FACILITIES, MOREOVER, IS JOINTLY DISCHARGED BY AMERICAN AND AUSTRALIAN PERSONNEL.

OBVIOUSLY, IF THE U.S. WERE TO RESTRICT AUSTRALIAN ACCESS TO ITS INTELLIGENCE, IT WOULD PERFORCE HAVE TO RESTRICT AUSTRALIAN ACCESS AT THESE FACILITIES AND BOTH CONSERVATIVE AND LABOR GOVERNMENTS NAVE MADE IT CLEAR THAT THIS WOULD BE UNACCEPTABLE.

IT IS, THEREFORE, SILLY TO INFER (AS SOME COMMENTATORS HAVE) THAT MY STATEMENT OF OPERATIONAL FACT IS SOMEHOW A THREAT. WHAT I OUTLINED WAS WHAT THE OBVIOUS CONSEQUENCE WOULD BE OF ANY DISRUPTION OF INTELLIGENCE ARRANGEMENTS. I DID SO TO MAKE CRYSTAL CLEAR AUSTRALIA'S POSITION, GIVEN SOME OF THE SOMEWHAT OVER-WROUGHT COMMENTS BEING MADE --POLITICALLY AND ELSEWHERE -- ABOUT ANZUS AND AUSTRALIA.
